I. INTRODUCTION TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL 2022

The United Nations Security Council (UNSC) was founded in 1945 as the League of Nations was transforming into the United Nations (UN) of our day.ⁱ Coming forward as a new establishment rather than a new organization, the United Nations embraces and authorizes the Security Council as an international organization that primarily aims to protect international peace and security.ⁱⁱ Examining the operation and the nature of the Security Council, one can see the clear reflections of the aims of the UN, which are listed in Article 1 of the Charter of the UN.ⁱⁱⁱ The Charter also imposes an obligation on Member States to implement the decisions made by the Security Council, consequently distinguishing the Council from other bodies of the UN, which are only authorized to present suggestions to the Member States.^{iv}

The Security Council gathers its sessions with 15 Members with each member being entitled to one vote for the purposes of decision-making.^v The said members are distinguished in two groups; Permanent Members and Non-Permanent Members. The Permanent Members of the Security Council, also known as the “permanent five” or the “P5”, are namely The Republic of China, France, The Russian Federation, The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and The United States of America.^{vi} The permanencies of these members derive from decisions taken in the formation process of the fundamentals of the Security Council. The fact that these States have also been equipped with a right to veto any action taken by the Security Council still maintains its influence on the international community of today, since the legal regulations of the authority of P5 remains intact. The ten Non-Permanent seats of the Council are allocated to Member States for a term of two year by the election carried out by the General Assembly.^{vii} The principle of equitable geographic distribution constitutes the criteria applied in these allocations.^{viii} Current Non-Permanent members of the Security Council are namely: India, Angola, Japan, Thailand, Sudan, Ukraine, Chile, Cuba, Netherlands and Germany.

Utilizing the abovementioned structure and authority, the Security Council takes the actions prescribed in the Chapter VI and VII of the Charter depending on the varying levels of severity of the disputes at hand. As the United Nations comes forward as a living entity that progressively expand to correspond with the alternation of the international community, the Security Council is intrigued into a constant evolution according to the modern needs of the world. Today, at its core, is actually no different than the past days of the Security Council. The chaotic and competitive nature of the humankind does not abandon the timeline, it is merely being juxtaposed with new technology, new disasters, new revelations and new objectives. The status of the year 2022 is built on great advancements in science and technology. Although, the possibilities of individual benefits have collectively created issues posing various threats to international security and peace. Man's steps on the Earth's Moon are now extended to other planets, orbits and moons. Now, the Security Council must face with the inadequacy of the international law regarding outer space since the exploration of which brings extensions of territories, placements of devices and naturally inter-state conflicts that take their tolls on also the face of the Earth. Considering the natural tragedies in our Earth caused by the neglectful and abusive use of resources by the humankind, the Council also faces with the usage of outer space that can ignite the sparks of nations colliding as their people and territories are punished by the nature. It should be mentioned that these problems are paralleled by the civilization on Earth, since we cannot avert from the predicted outcomes of global warming. This old problem is now much greater than a prediction and has already drifted away from resulting in humanitarian issues. Sinking cities, floods, tsunamis, melting ice, severe draught, extreme heat and the extinction of forms of life shoved the world into an inescapable environment filled with chaos, rebellion, and bloodshed. It is not easy for a person to embrace doom and the primal survival instincts of humans caused the initiation of a Water War in Africa and Middle East, overpopulation in inland regions of the world, heavy migration, deaths by natural disasters, refugee crises. One should not grasp these

issues individually. Beyond the mentioned singular complications, there are groups ready to crush others to obtain livable circumstances and this inevitably turns nations against each other. Diseases and fatalities caused by the rising temperature and global sea level necessitates international cooperation as much as the decrease in water reserves require noble actions from States that hold solutions for the attainment of potable water. Meanwhile, there are States colliding for the circumstantial “benefits” of the global warming, such as the revelation of further oil reserves in the Arctic Region. A rather traditional terror also reigns over Middle East, especially Syria, a region that hosts bombings and separatist actions on a daily basis regardless of the variance of the main actors of the conflict. The depressing history of the said region now left the world with another territory and countless lives ruined by the advancement in nuclear weaponry, Latakia. Striving to manage this unpopulated area under maybe a disguise of newly found peace, Syria continues to be inhabited by groups with conflicting legacies. The Middle East does not bound its problems within the borders drawn on a piece of paper and the people victimized by the past conflicts seek peace and home in Europe, unfortunately disrupting the internal order and security of other countries. As nearly a million is being held in the Greek island of Euboia the European Union lives under border security problems and diplomatic accusations continue to impair the already clouded relationships within the EU. Another great problem around the European land stands as the Ukraine-Russia conflict, which transformed from diplomatic and domestic issues into an enormous international controversy that seems like a partial repetition of the European history. It is known that the fight between Ukraine and Russia revolves around the concept of self-determination and is appropriate interpretation and application. The same matter, also combined with competition on resources, gave rise to similar demands and subsequent problems in various regions of the world such as Angola and Tibet. A relief does not seem near, while Catalonia managed to gain the recognition of several States even though remaining in troubled status with various others. Finally, it should be borne in mind while assessing the current

international balance that the developing technology now provides us with operations that can be considered nearly-creationist, such as ectogenesis; birth in an artificial uterus. It is this exact perspective that irritates religious beliefs of certain States and damages international peace. Also, the abuse of the mentioned technology and similar ones demands strict security regulations for States to be able to retain their citizens. Competition among States in space technologies is also suitable for the usage of such technologies as subjects of accusations are allegations regarding State activities that are being conducted undercover. Now, this hectic world calls for the attention of the Security Council and their actions that can repair international security and peace.

II. TIMELINE: 2017- 2022

March

March 6th - April 25th - The Russian Military Intervention is still progressing in the northern regions of Syria. Attacks are reported to be targeting both ISIS forces and also rebel groups opposing the internationally recognized Syrian government led by Bashar al-Assad.

March 10th - March 4th - Republic of India joined The International Space Program as a new partner. The program is a joint project among five participating space agencies: NASA (United States of America), Roscosmos (Russian Federation), JAXA (Japan), European Space Agency and Canadian Space Agency. With the participation of India, the budget of International Space Program was increased. Thus, the International Space Station seems to be providing services at least until 2028. The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) declared a space program. Main headings of space program is as follows:

2018: Republic of India plans first manned space mission.

2021: Republic of India aims to have astronauts land on Moon

2025: Republic of India aims to send their own space station

March- 20th Spanish financial crisis, which began in 2008 as a reflection of the World Financial Crisis of 2007- 08, continues. On the other hand, Catalan pro-independence supporters organized a demonstration under the name of "*Catalonia, the next state in Europe*" in Barcelona. Catalonia was a critical contributor to Spain's economy. If the Region of Catalonia were to declare independence, it would take a major portion of Spain's economic power with it. This seems to be troubling news for Spain.

March 22nd - March 13th- The Prime Minister of the United Kingdom, David Cameron addressed the European Union Summit of the previous month, expressing that the outcome of the meeting brought new commitments to the European Union for the betterment of their relations for the UK. The talks for a referendum on the country's membership seem to be suspended for now.

March 24th- The rebel groups are pushing the minor IS forces towards the Turkish border and taking control of several areas below Deir ez-Zor. The strengthening of the rebel groups is likely caused by their new positioning strategy and the US support gained through their moderate approach on the Assad government and IS forces.

March 25th - March 21st - A group of activists made a gigantic graffito on the Red Square, Russia. On the 330 meters long Square, beginning from State Museum to the St. Basil's Cathedral, "From Russia, with Love" is written with huge letters, which can only be read through bird's eye, with a rainbow background. The activists, who were clearly trying to give a message regarding the intense pressure towards LGBT citizens, had been searched for throughout the country. The activist group of approximately 250 people could not be detected because of a cyber-attack

towards the central surveillance camera system of Moscow on the night before. The graffiti had been erased by the municipality workers' hard work of three and a half hours. Support for the activist group throughout the world had been the top subject in social media for the following weeks.

March 25th - After the impeachment of Dilma Rousseff, who was the first female president of Brazil from Workers' Party, due to the corruption claims, Michel Temer came into force from Brazilian Democratic Movement Party.

March 26th - Non-payment of police wages occurred in Rio 2016 Olympics Games livened again. A large-scale of protest in the streets of Sao Paolo began.

March 30th - The protest started in Sao Paolo spread throughout the country. In total, 30000 police officers attended to the protests

April

April- 3rd Iraq declared that their troops killed the last remaining ISIS forces in Tikrit and managed to control the hundred percent of the city, located about 90 miles north of the Capital Baghdad.

April 10th - The lack of payment of the salaries brought about the Increase in bribery given to the officers.

April 15th - Russia deployed 2.000 troops in Jarabulus in order to control the Kurdish forces.

April 17th - Following the protest, the rate of crime in the country started drastically rise.

April 20th - The streets, neighborhoods, cities started to have security problems due to the breach of duty by the police.

April 21st - A severe drought in Mexico that cost farmers more than a billion dollars in crop losses alone and set back the national cattle herd for years, is just a foretaste of the drier future facing Latin America's second largest economy. Authorities were alarmed to face such a condition in April, in which rains usually serve as a great boost for the agricultural sector. Farmers are worried for the summer.

April 23rd - A close relationship between one of the biggest contraction companies, Camargo Correa and the President Michel Temer was reflected in the press. Camargo Correa has been increasingly winning construction tender initiated by the state since Temer was in the charge.

April 24th - In Colombia, the negotiations between the government and FARC have been continuing in a vicious cycle. The public's denial for peace talks in the referendum held in early 2016 plugged the channels.

April 25th - Ukrainian Board Guard Chief declared that the "Great Ukrainian Wall" project has shown little progress. The project, worth of 250 million dollars, will provide Ukraine with a much more elaborate defense system than a concrete wall rising between Russia and Ukraine. The Wall

aims to divide Russia and the problematic Ukrainian regions by creating a block along the 2.500 kilometers long Russian-Ukrainian border. The defense system will include barbed wire-fences, tall steel fortifications, large antitank ditches, remote combat modules, surveillance systems, alarms and communicational facilities. The guards announced that the ditches are still being dug and the continuance of the project at a higher pace depends on further funding. As the wall seems close to the length of the fence system along the USA-Mexican border, it can be estimated that Ukraine will suffer from the construction and maintenance expenses of this project.

April 27th - March 23th - The tension between Ukraine and the Russian Federation rose over the Donetsk Region. Prime Minister of Ukraine, Petro Poroshenko claimed that Russia deployed her military experts and some troops to the Donetsk Region. The Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe, which controls hundreds of cease-fire monitors deployed to Ukrainian Conflict Areas, confirmed military activity on the site. On the other hand, Military Spokesman of the Russian Army said that *“According to the invitation of Donetsk People’s Republic our military experts control the United Armed Forces of Novorossiya, which was regarded as terrorist group by the Government of Ukraine and he attached that our efforts to aim peaceful settlement.”*

May

May 4th- Boko Haram attacked private mining companies of France in Ivory Coast. 98 people, comprised of 50 militants, at least 3 French and 2 Ivory Coast soldiers, and 41 company employees, were killed in clashes between Boko Haram militants and soldiers. It is reported that the attacks are still in continuance.

May 5th- Boko Haram continued their bloody attacks in Nigeria and Ivory Coast. One of the most important prisons of Nigeria, Ogun Prison, which is located in Southwestern Nigeria, was attacked

by militants. About 125 prisoners, who were linked to the terrorist organization, escaped. The Nigerian Army launched an operation in order to locate the prisoners. Also, 35 were killed in a bombing attack by Boko Haram Militants in Abidjan, the economic capital and the largest city of Ivory Coast.

May 6th From America to Australia, the Pope, State Presidents and Prime Ministers have declared solidarity with the French and Ivory Coast people. François Hollande stated: *“We were shocked by events in Paris lately and now Ivory Coast. It’s an attack not just on the people of the said regions. In fact, this is an attack on all of humanity and the universal values we share.”* Also, The President of the National Front, Marine Le Pen said: *“The security situation in the Ivory Coast has gravely deteriorated in the last three days. It’s time to take a firm action against terrorism.”* On the other hand, President of United States of America stated: *“We’re going to do whatever it takes to work with the French and Ivory Coast people and with nations around the world to bring these terrorists to justice and to go after any terrorist networks that target our people.”*

May 15th -Nearly two weeks after the terrorist attacks against French companies in Ivory Coast, that claimed the lives of 133 people and injured about 200, the French Parliament voted to give the country’s government powers to make a cross-border operations and increase the number of French peacekeeping forces in Ivory Coast also to block social media services and websites in state of emergency.

May- 17th Once again, Kurdish Forces (YPG) were preparing for large-scale operations against Jarabulus, Syria. On the other hand, Turkey has provided \$600 million to the Kurdish Regional Government (KPG), located in northern Iraq, in order to build a safety line from Hanakin to Rabia against ISIS. The President of Kurdish Regional Government, Massoud Barzani, stated that *“Self-*

determination denotes the legal right of people to decide their own destiny in the international order. All human beings have the right to self-determination. There is no reason to exclude Kurds from being entitled to the right of self-determination.” an he added that *“Without the contribution and permission of Turkey, we disapprove of YPG operation against Jarabulus.”* On the other side, Iraq’s former prime-minister Nouri-Al Maliki noted: *“We never allow autonomy and independence movements of Kurdish Regional Government. Also, with this efforts, Turkey harms the national sovereignty of Iraq.”*

May 17th - The Climate Change Group published a report on the predicted Global Sea Rise Levels. The report warns the international community regarding the risk of 1.400 cities submergence by the year of 2100. Asserting that a closer future of 2030 may come with destructive results for the East Coast of the United States of America, especially Florida, and for Bangkok, which showed approximately 6 inches of sea rise only in the last century.

May 20th - France and Ivory Coast began holding joint military exercises.

May 22th- France launched a military operation against jihadists, after being asked to intervene by the President of Ivory Coast. The African Union Commission President expressed his feelings: *“I welcome ongoing efforts of the France mission in Ivory Coast to protect the civilian population in line with UN Charter.”*

May 23rd- Government spokesman of Russian Federation held a press conference and stated that: *“ We are concerned about France’s recent deployment of military forces to Ivory Coast. A French military activity in Africa raises serious questions. Additionally, Russia has successful history of fighting Islam-oriented terrorism. Therefore, the international community should comprehend that*

in Either Syria or Africa, global fight against terror is impossible without the engagement of Russia.”

June

June 1st - April 29th - Japan Family Planning Association (JFPA) reported that nearly half of the women between the ages of 16-24 are avoiding sexual contact. The Association noted that Japan may suffer from great declines in population in the near future, if necessary actions are taken in order to improve the psychological conditions that the Japanese are suffering from, which leads them into a tendency to avoid sexual intercourse. Previous studies of Dr. Yoshinori Kuwabara of Juntendo University (Tokyo), which demonstrated that goat fetuses can be grown up to three weeks in artificial environments containing special fluids, were referred. The JFPA noted that said studies provided only pre-millennial achievements and the progressing technology is at a higher stage to actually accomplish birth outside a natural womb, or in other words; ectogenesis.

June 6th - Republic of China captured the capital of North Korea, Pyongyang. After an unsuccessful appeal, six Generals under the command of Kim-Jong Un were executed by Chinese forces. The whereabouts of Kim Jong-Un remains undiscovered.

June 10th - The Villarica Volcano in central Chile erupted. The volcano usually creates mild explosions yet this one seemed to be reaching to a 30 km perimeter around the volcano. Luckily, there were no housings or persons within the explosion area.

June 17th- Jaargen Michael, a Czech politician, announced his candidacy for the presidential elections with the catchphrase; “Looking for a President? Czech Ja Mike.”

June 17th- The Zika virus, an alarming and disturbing infection that may be linked to thousands of babies being born with underdeveloped brains, is spreading through the America. The virus so far caused over 300 babies born underdeveloped. Affected areas include Eastern peninsulas of America and worries European communities for potential vault.

June 23rd- The Greek citizens in Euboia organized a huge protest blaming the government for the destruction of their homes by the placement of the refugees. 400 refugees and 380 citizens died during the clashes that rose between the refugees and the Greek citizens.

June 24th - Angola and Russia signed military, economic, technical-scientific and commercial cooperation agreements. The President of Angola José Eduardo dos Santos - also the leader of the People’s Movement for the Liberation of Angola, which ruled Angola since the country’s independence from Portugal in 1975 - have stated that Angola is continuing all military and civilian cooperation with Russia regarding the battle against terrorism in Africa. According to abovementioned agreements, Russian-Angolan air forces will be equipped with Russian manufactured Su-24 aircrafts and Ka-26 helicopters. The steps of Russian Federation increased the tension in Africa.

June 25th- Israeli Prime Minister stated that “U.S deal with Iran is legitimizing Iran's nuclear program and therefore it is going to lead to a nuclear arms race in the Middle East. With the hundreds of billions of dollars of relief, this deal will fuel Iran's support for terror around the

world. A nuclear Iran is a threat not only to Israel but to the entire free world.” It remained precarious whether Netanyahu tried to intimidate the Islamist Republic of Iran, or the U.S.

June 26th - The United States of America supported the rebel groups fighting with the Assad supporters by personnel and equipment aid. It was observed that the rebels are outmanned facing the Kurdish Government and the Assad-supporting groups.

July

July 24th - NASA published a report on global warming. According to this report, global sea level has risen by about 8 inches due to reliable records kept from 1880 to date. It is projected to rise another 1 to 4 feet by 2060. This is the result of the melting land ice and the expansion of seawater as it warms. If necessary measures are not taken, the rise will only rise with a higher accumulation after 2060 because the oceans take a very long time to respond to warmer conditions at the Earth's surface. Thus, we may suffer from the outcomes of the current climate changes that are not yet observable. Additionally, NASA enumerated several other complications the world may suffer from as; increase in the Earth's average temperature, changes in the patterns and amounts of precipitation, reduction of ice and snow cover as well as permafrost, increase at the global sea level, increase in the acidity of the oceans, increase in the frequency, intensity, and/or duration of extreme events relating to ocean activity, shifts in the ecosystem characteristics, increase in threats to human health. If such outcomes become existent, they will impact our food supply, water resources, infrastructure, ecosystems, and health.

July 28th - Kim-Jong-Un was captured by Chinese Forces in Kaesong, a city near the borderline between the North Korea and South Korea, as a result of ‘Operation Badhair’. The government spokesman of Republic of China stated that *“It is a great day for the democratic world, Kim-Jong-Un was a menace to the Korean Peninsula, and his reign of terror will be remembered for its brutality, aggression and oppression. Now, the former dictator will face justice.”*

August

August 2nd - In the Pyongyang Trials, carried out by the People’s Republic China, Kim-Jong-Un was found guilty of crimes against humanity and was sentenced to death by shooting.

August 7th - Military domination in Thailand ended. Thais go to polls to elect their new President. A general election in Thailand could come in September 2017.

July 8th: An oil painting of Dutch master Vincent Van Gogh is discovered in a basement in London, with an estimated worth of \$320 billion. The painting was donated to the National Gallery.

July 9th: After decades of dispute, Chinese military proceed to create a “Navy controlled zone” around the Senkaku Islands. While the Chinese officials state that this is merely a precaution against the unauthorized fishing boats US Secretary of State stated that *“This is nothing short of a blockade.”*

August 10th - Military domination in Thailand ended. Thais go to polls to elect their new President.

A general election in Thailand could come in September 2017

August 11th- The United States Department of Justice published a press release, condemning China for dealing with the matters in North Korea by themselves. The US Government views that the North Korean issue had become a global concern and the alleged responsible for all the crimes committed should have been adjudicated in transparency and due to the norms set by the international law.

August 15th- As the Syrian Conflict rises, the shelter seekers crossing over to Europe has increased to a number of 800.000. The European Union warns Greece to take appropriate measures if they want to avoid any legal action to be taken regarding the Schengen Agreement.

August 24th - Prime Minister of Netherlands Mark Rutte attended a national conference about the studies on climate change and possible precautions. Mr. Rutte stated that; “ It is prescribed that the best case scenario for the next 70 years is a 0.5 meters of Global Sea Level Rise. Considering the geology of our country, we can see that even such an event can destroy a significant region of Netherlands, starting from the shore. Thus, I support the barrier projects and the elevation of our settlement for the sake of our future. If we do not take the appropriate measures, our suffering will be severe and irreversible.”

August 25th - Russia organized a new air strike on the Kurdish forces located near the Turkish border of Syria.

August- 27th - Prime Minister of Ukraine, Arseny Yatsenuk announced that the Great Ukrainian Wall Project will be completed with a delay, due to financial inconveniences that disrupted the flow of the ground section of the project. The large ditches, setting a ground for the elaborate

defense system, are estimated to be finished in the following 8 months. It seems that the wall will not rise in 2018. Considering the higher expenses and workload required by the further sections of the project, the early phases of 2020 seems to be the appropriate date for the completion of the whole project.

September

September 5th - Up to 15 million bees were found dead in California. Following this ‘natural phenomenon’, scientists make a statement: *“Bees are in serious and immediate risk from the human-caused climate change. Governments need to take measures before it was too late. Bear in mind what Einstein once said; ‘If the bee disappeared off the surface of the globe, then man would have only four years of life left. No more bees, no more pollination, no more plants, no more animals, no more man.’”*

September 14th - Kurdish forces launched an attack on the headquarters of the Islamic State radical group (ISIS) in Jarabulus city north of Aleppo, near the border with Turkey. The Kurdish famous YPG fighter Gökberk Azadi told, *“We have plans to liberate Jarabulus. That’s one small step for us yet one giant leap towards victory. We are trying to capture the last border crossing point between Syria and Turkey held by Isis, making it impossible for jihadist volunteers from Europe and elsewhere to reach Isis-held territories. The anti-ISIS operations will continue until reassuring our people’s safety from this terrorist group”* On the other hand, Russian Air Strikes have focused on helping the Syrian Kurds. Following this development, Turkish Prime Minister said that *“We will never allow the expansionist policy of YPG, simply because they are the Syrian*

branch of the PKK”. A military convoy, including the carriage howitzers, was reported as traveling from the city of Gaziantep to the Syrian border.

September 15th - The Turkish Military Force began to fire artillery on targets inside Jarabulus.

September 18th - The European Environment Agency expressed concerns about the climate change and global warming effects on the territory of the European Union. The Agency specifically warns Netherlands, Belgium and Luxembourg, as they are the countries located at a lower altitude. Regional governments and the Community Institutions engage in the formation of specialized commissions and working groups for possible measures to be taken.

27th September - European Union has proposed a new deal to Greece. According to this new monetary aid proposal, the European Union will wipe off %37 percent of Greek debts, which amounts to a total of 363,919,962,973 €, provided that the Greek government accepts to establish permanent refugee regions in Lesbos and Chios islands. The people of Greece, especially supporters of far- right parties, described the European Union offer as a political oppression and an indecent proposal.

September 25th - A retired military man and the leader of the Pheu Thai Party, Ti Nung Cha Leeyao was elected Thailand’s Prime Minister.

September 25th - 45 people from the Turkish Jet Society were severely injured during the LC Waikiki X Chanel Event.

September 26th- Russian air strikes continued on the IS forces located near Aleppo, which is currently under the control of the Hezbollah groups and the remaining government supporters.

October

October 3rd - Sanctions imposed by Western nations on Russia over its involvement in the Ukraine crisis and Syrian Civil war has hurt the Russian economy. Russian Federation's unemployment rate was observably increased. People protested Vladimir Putin claiming that he was reckless in his strategies and protesters attacked the police and public buildings in Moscow. The leader of the opposition party, Alexei Navalny, states, *"It is time to take steps against Putin's policies. We will stand behind our cause and we are confident that other opposition parties will join us for the sake of Mother Russia!"*

October 15th The rebel groups defeated in Aleppo are moving towards the southern regions of Syria, which are still partially under rebel control. It is expected that the rebel groups get support from the US government in order to battle with the governmental forces in Latakia.

October 10th- The situation of migrants, who came from Syria, Iraq and Afghanistan, on the Greek island of Kos was out of control. There were about 15.000 refugees and illegal migrants already on the Aegean Sea island. The Greek Police tried to transfer about 5000 of them to camp in Mora island. Migrants have demanded their settlement in Germany and France and have refused to seek asylum in any other European Country.

October 11th- The Legal Subcommittee of the United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space (UN COPUOS LSC) discussed the holding of a conference regarding the modern regulations on space usage. The discussion was initiated by the delegate of Japan, corresponding with the previous declarations made by the Japanese government. The final report of the LSC read that a conference (Tokyo Conference) will be held in Tokyo and all members of the COPUOS will attend to draft the treaty. The conference will be held as a special session of the Legal Subcommittee in Japan.

October 12th - The Dutch State Committee for Durable Coast Development published a new advisory report regarding the sea level rise. The Committee stated that they advised “sand replenishment” and “dike constructions” basing on the previous rise level statistics yet that the accumulation of the rising rate is much higher than expected. The Committee advises that stronger measures, such as evacuation of the threatened areas and broader barriers, should be taken.

October 13th - A member of the Neo-Fascist Greek party, Golden Dawn, killed four refugees in broad daylight in Greece. *“If Michaloliakos and members of Golden Dawn are not released, we will kill more migrants. Seal the Border! Stop the Invasion! Save our Country!”* stated the murderer during the trial. On the other hand, the trials of Nikolaos Michaloliakos, leader of Golden Dawn, and other members of Europe’s most violent neo-Nazi political party are still continuing.

October 17th - The Kurdish Government supporters around Jarabulus captured and executed 70 Russian soldiers with a globally broadcasted demonstration. The Russian air strikes and the remaining soldiers were ordered to focus solely on the Kurdish fighters. President Putin stated;

“We will end this once and for all. We have stated our beliefs in diplomatic solutions but this crossed a line.”

October 19th- The internal conflicts in Europe caused various States that are members of the European Space Agency to avoid engaging in a Space Station Project. The United Kingdom, Germany and France are the three Member States that support the initiation of such a project considering their partners in the International Space Station have already launched or are in the progress of launching an individual Space Station. The Member States did not contest the execution of the project if it was financed by the said three States. In exchange for the exclusive rights to the Station, UK, Germany and France agreed to support the project under the mandate of the European Space Agency.

October 24th- The CEO of the Middle East Development LLC announces that the Bridge of the Horns Project, a project for the construction of a bridge connecting Africa and Middle East from Yemen to Djibouti that was suspended in 2010, is revitalized. The Bridge will be likely completed in 2020.

November

November 4th- Putin delivered a speech in Red Square due to National Unity Day; *“Turkey and their western allied powers were creating a zone of chaos in Syria. We cannot let that happen. On the other hand, recently we observed that the Ukraine Government deployed their troops in East. On behalf of the government of Russia, I would like to declare a warning to the government of Ukraine. Ukraine needs to respect the rights of the people of Crimea and recognize a Right of*

Secede for Donetsk. That is what the international law prescribes, not the intervention of a region that seeks to determine their own fate!”

November 7th- The mortgage crisis was experienced on the Eastern Europe; Croatia was currently stabilized with government intervention. However, according to critics, Eastern European countries’ budgetary deficit was affected immensely.

November 13th- Zika virus is detected in Portugal and Spain. Officials report that health security in outer border controls of the European Union will be strengthened.

November 25th - A new book of J.K Rowling, Harry Potter and the Cursed Child, was published.

December

December 1st - The Netherlands Flood Prevention Project is officially initiated. The project will require the construction of sea barriers that could block the inbound water movements, linear protection of the coastline and the elevation of the development across the shore. The Project is run by the Dutch State Committee for Durable Coast Development.

December 6th - After the capture of Ramadi, the Iraqi Army started an attack to dislodge IS militants from the center of Mosul, Iraq’s second-largest city. Kurdish Peshmerga forces launched a major offense against ISIS forces in west of Mosul to assist Iraqi troops in their effort to retake

the city from the radical group. *“Operations to liberate Mosul require time. It is not easy to cleanse the city from the cancer that has been striving to corrupt the heritage of this region and its people.”* stated the Commander of Peshmerga Forces.

December 15th - Christmas and new year’s decorations, celebration related items, clothing and food have been banned in several Middle East countries. Five days after the reported gatherings, the west turned its attention to the news on Christmas and New Year’s in Middle East.

December 25th - After the explosion of a nuclear weapon in North Korea, The World Health Organization released a report that estimates an increase in risk of specific cancers for certain subsets of the population near the nuclear disaster zone. On the other hand, United Nations Scientific Committee on the Effects of Atomic Radiation (UNSCEAR) declared dose-rem levels of nuclear disaster zone as a 4000. Chinese military forces controlled the region.

2018

January

January 5th - The conflict between the Ukrainian army and rebel forces has killed more than 11,400 people. Ukrainian troops began military operations to capture Donetsk Sergey Prokofiev International Airport and destroy Pro-Russian fighters. This operation was conducted by Ukrainian Special forces, which were trained by US military experts. Ukrainian Prime Minister warned that Russia’s *“terrorists”* have launched a major military offensive on January 3, in eastern Ukraine. This seems to be the most possible objective behind the retaliation against them. The Russian Foreign Ministry Official expressed in a press conference that; *“We declare once again that any sanctions against Russia would be groundless and counterproductive.”*

January 10th - Despite the denial, the government's efforts in having a common ground and establishing peace with FARC slowly but constantly started to result in dissatisfaction among the people.

January 12th- Taking advantage of the Russian absence around Aleppo, the rebel forces entered into the city with the support of the US-led air strikes. The Aleppo battles were ignited between the government forces and the rebels supported by the United States.

January 17th -The Iraqi Army has controlled 80 percent of Mosul. The US Government Spokesman found that : “...*the operation was incandescent. The United States will continue targeting ISIS.*”

January 18th- People's Republic of China issued a press release supporting the Tokyo Conference on the Peaceful Use of Space.

January 20th- Severe draught is taking its toll on Middle East and North Africa. Sudan and Egypt is striving to protect their water reserves and hydroelectric energy facilities from protests and rogue attacks.

February

February 5th - Angolan Armed Forces initiated operations against separatist Angolan movements in Luanda, a border town between Congo and Angola. The Operation “Fist of Steel” was the one the most large-scale operations into Angola and was intended to disrupt the logistical support and the

command & control capabilities of separatist groups. The Spokesman of the United States of America asserted concerns about the situation in Angola.

February 6th - December- 25th UN Security Council called an emergency meeting to discuss North Korea's reported test of a hydrogen bomb.

February 7th- A disastrous tsunami hit the city of Bangkok. The cause of the event was reported as an earthquake with magnitude of a 9.1 in the South China Sea. Several regions of Pattaya and Pathom are also affected. The death toll is currently 286.504 and rising. The world is alarmed and the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs is holding emergency sessions regarding humanitarian assistance.

February 8th- The death toll of the Bangkok Tsunami reached 300.000. Approximately 94.340 buildings are destroyed, 3.000 bodies remain unidentified. The UNOCHA-coordinated humanitarian assistance is highly appreciated by the Thai government. Given these, UNOCHA once more called member states to provide any form of humanitarian assistance, regardless of their economic status. People, residing in the affected area, have been evacuated to Pattaya, a city 2-hours from Bangkok.

February 20th - Ukraine declared that their troops killed the last remaining Pro-Russian militant forces in Donetsk Sergey Prokofiev International Airport and took over the entire control of the airport.

March

March 3rd - A group in charge of the preservation of Venice, Consorzio Venezia Nuova, told the media that Venice is also a city under the threat of being submerged by waters. The group indicated that they have been expecting the submerge of the city yet the speed of the event approaching is way higher than their expectations. The group had declared that the rate was 8 times higher than what they have foreseen approximately ten years before.

March 11th - The Presidential Election in Russia was held on 11th March. The election resulted with the victory of Vladimir Putin. The Leader of the United Russia Party and Incumbent Russian President, Vladimir Putin, was elected once again with a 64% vote. Millions went out to streets for protests.

March 26th - Iraq Army has controlled 100 percent of Mosul. Iraq Prime Minister stated in a press conference that: *“The enemy is weaker and on the defense. ISIS has lost 55 percent of its territory in Iraq.”*

March 30th - Desalinization methods are becoming widespread in the European Industry. The Middle East and Africa is still left without a solution for the drying rivers and rebel groups clashing for water.

April

April 1st - December 23th - The United States Army sent two Nuclear-powered aircraft carriers to the South Korean Port. The United States of America invited Chinese leader, Xi Jinping in order to seek an agreement for the resolution of problems caused by the actions of North Korea.

April 4th - 20 Mexican Soldiers were killed by a Mexican Cartel. By the end of March, the official death toll of Mexican Drug War was at least 180.000.

April 10th - In 2018 elections, Juan Manuel Santos Calderon was reelected as the President. However, the allegations about cheating on elections were expressed a lot.

April 18th - FASAT-Charlie, the Chilean satellite built by the partnership of Chilean Air Forces and the UK-based Surrey Satellite Technologies Ltd. started operating. The first 2D and 3D images of the Chilean territory were received.

April 23rd - Donetsk People's Republic supporters attacked the border guards working at the Great Ukrainian Wall Project along the Russian border. 6 guards were killed.

May

May 5th - Protests in Russia continued. 34 protestors died during clashes with police.

May 6th - The United Nations World Food Programme (UNWFP) took action against the spreading trend of loots on walnuts by the Arrogant Ravioli Squad. The UNWFP published a report on a state-of-the-art nutrient called “qeshéjevisse” that could be used as a substitute for both walnuts and yoghurt.

May 10th - Due to the rumors, there are some senior generals that are uncomfortable about the negotiations with FARC. According to those in the know, these generals could be intending to take some actions in parallel with the public thought, the unrest with the peace negotiations.

May 10th - In social media, some started a hashtag “#nohaynegociacionesconterroristas”, meaning “no negotiations with terrorists. In 5 hours, the hashtag became trend topic in Colombia.

May 13th - A few days later, the number of tweets with that hashtag reached 3 million.

May 16th - The battles in Aleppo are still in continuance with the participation of Hezbollah, anti-Assad rebel groups and the ISIS. A major involvement of the US forces is seen to be weakening the government supporters.

May 18th - The United States of America Individual Space Station was successfully repaired. The DoD took no blame for the undetected piece of debris and stated that they are using state of the art technology for the surveillance of this problem. The Department added that the debris situation in the space could amount to much bigger problems if the debris start to conjunct.

May 20th - The Angolan and Russian governments have signed a new military cooperation agreement during Angola temporary President one-day official visit to Moscow at the weekend. The Russian president stressed that both Russia and Angola share similar points of view related to international issues. Also, Russia promised to help Angola to modernize Angolan Armed Forces.

May 26th - Golden Dawn members in Mora Island, Greece declared war on refugees. Members of Neo-Fascist Greece Party shouted anti-immigrant slogans and clashed with police forces and volunteers who had gathered to donate help and supplies to migrants arriving at a Mora refugees' camp. Also, the supporters of Golden Dawn marched to prison where Michaloliakos was taken. Protestors prepared tents and camps around the prison. According to claim they will not leave

until the release the leader of Golden Dawn. On the other side, three wooden boats, packed with refugees, sank in the waters of the Aegean Sea. Forty-four people, mostly women and children, died when their boat sank off the island of Lesbos, which is a Greek island located in the northeastern Aegean Sea, Head of Hellenic Coast Guard Yigitidis said.

May 26th- The German Government pointed out to the reanimation of the border control issues and blamed the Greek government with failing to come up with an actually functioning solution to the refugee problem. It was stated by the German government official that the Greek approach is worsening the already-bad situation within the European Union.

May 27th- Japan deals with the wave of four tsunami incidents in a row that hit Tsu and Sendai cities. Disaster was announced as a record in the disasters history of past fifty years not with the degree of power of waves, but the level of demolition in the disastrous area. Almost two thirds of the region was under water, 23,000 people were reported missing and 8,500 dead. The NGO's Association declared joint campaign to gather around as much help as they can, more than anywhere else.

May 28th - Chief of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and his Deputy visited NATO Headquarters. Secretary General of NATO told that we came together with our Ukraine friends. As we all know, Ukraine and NATO have been partners for several years. Also he attached: NATO will provide both political and practical assistance to Ukraine in response to the serious challenges the country faces.

June

June 14th - The 2018 World Cup, an international football event, was held in 2018 in Russian Federation. The opening ceremony was held at the Luzhniki Stadium. Russia used the opening ceremony for propaganda purposes. Russia promoted the image of a new and strong Russia.

June 18th - The rebel forces fighting in Aleppo are relieved as the government supporters get weaker. The rebel forces, having a cosmopolite structure within them, are seen to be extending throughout a line under the northern border of Syria, where the IS forces and the Kurdish forces are primarily located. As the rebel groups consist various ideologies, it is observed that while the Alevis are focusing on the Deir ez-Zor area for the fight against ISIS and the Sunnis are currently targeting Aleppo and the remaining government support in the South area.

June 25th - Prime Minister Arseny Yatsenyuk responded to the criticism upon the failure of the Ukrainian Government regarding the Great Ukrainian Wall construction. Mr. Yatsenyuk stated that Ukraine is suffering from the separation of its people harshly. He stated that the government believes that the wall will be able to block Russia from triggering the rebel groups in Donetsk and that only then the country will be able to finally stand on their feet again. He concluded with his confidence on the progress of the construction and expressed that the wall would be standing in 2020.

July

July 9th - A lawyer and director general of Iraq's Ministry of Justice, Mustafa Bebarek Al-Kaleciki has been appointed as the mayor of Mosul. After this step, tensions spiked between the Kurdish leadership and Iraq's central government.

July 14th - The situation in Syria is keeping its severity while the conflicted areas are being narrowed down. The rebel forces are now located in the vast majority of the south, partially in Aleppo and, in the middle region by positioning throughout a line going through Deir ez-Zor.

July 22nd - The planned barriers are completed along the shore of Netherlands. The "Netherlands Flood Prevention" Project will continue with coastal armoring, which will provide a linear protection for the stabilization of the shoreline. The later agenda of the Project is the elevated settlement stage.

July 23th - The tension between Ukraine and the Russian Federation rose once again. President of Russian Federation, Vladimir Putin, claimed that Ukrainian forces deployed some troops to Donetsk Region and they were preparing large scale operations against Donetsk in order to capture city and he attached that all states, especially Ukraine, should respect sovereignty right of Donetsk People's Republic. Also he added that respecting the sovereignty means preventing coups, unconstitutional actions and illegitimate overthrowing of the legitimate government.

August

August 5th- Secretary General of the Council of Europe Thorbjørn Jagland spoke about the Ukrainian Wall again, reiterating that the European Union will start taking further and stricter measures against this approach of Ukraine. While the territorial integrity of Ukraine is a priority, Mr. Jagland speaks for Europe on their view that sees such walls as unnecessary and an inaccurate repetition of the history.

August 10th- President of Germany Dennis Eichtvogel addressed the Ukrainian government. Mr. Eichtvogel stressed that Germany is still suffering from the burdens of the Berlin Wall and expressed his country's perspective that supports the abolishment of such measures. "Europe is always better off without these walls." were his concluding words.

August 15th- Cornell University achieved to fully grow a mouse fetus in an artificial womb. Dr. Equinne O'ne published an article on the production of the artificial womb and the containment liquid that allowed the growth of the fetus. The press conference subsequent to this publication was interfered by a small New York oriented conservative and religious group that accused Dr. O'ne with "playing God" and the group repeatedly stated that he "*will be punished when the time comes for the great judgment*". The local police suppressed the occasion and no injuries were reported.

August 30th - The operation under the name of Preventing Iron Curtain is initiated by NATO in the eastern Mediterranean on 30 August 2018. NATO Secretary-General Herr Jens Stoltenberg said that the operation preventing iron curtain is a great importance in order to discourage possible risks and threats and illegal acts.

September

September 4th - Ukrainian forces took action regarding the city of the Donetsk in this early morning. As a result of assault 23 separatist soldiers and two Russian military experts died. Following this development in Donetsk, the leader of the separatist movement has called the Russian Federation to defend their sovereignty, which based on United Nations Charter. On the other side, *“Ukrainian armed forces are ready to not only for the suppression of rebel attacks, but if necessary for countering enemy forces”* Spokesman of Ukraine Government said.

September 14th- With the relieved sanctions and gained international legitimacy Iran has become a stronger hegemony in the eyes of West. The complicated proxy wars in Middle East and the immoderate maneuvers of Saudi Arabia and Qatar made Iran the center of soft and smart power.

September 24th - In order to fix their deteriorating economy, Government of Spain adopted a 4-year economic development plan.

October

October 6th - The Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe(OSCE) has said that its monitors continued to observe human rights violations in Ukraine, especially torture. The OSCE attached that most of violence they observed occurred in residential areas.

October 9th - Six Tibetans died in Garze, a Tibetan-majority area of China's southwestern Sichuan province, after police opened fire on unarmed protesters. The protests in Garze were sparked by the arrest of a famous local leader.

October 13th- A new pill that can block the functioning of the P21 gene and allow adult mammal cells to behave like embryonic regenerative stem cells, is release. This medication constitutes great hope for amputees as they will be able to grow their limbs back.

October 20th- In the post-sanction era, Iranian Financial System gained power by re-establishing its links with Europe. The new era reduced Iran's dependence on oil and provided an opportunity to gain leverage against West through the usage of relieved assets.

October 23rd - More than ten thousand people have died in the Ukraine Conflict since it began. The world is anxious for a resolution of this conflict.

October 25th- The Caribbean Coral Reefs are on the edge of destruction due to the rising sea temperature and acidification.

October 27th- Regular inspections at Iran's nuclear installations did not take place. The Western Powers called for arrangements to re-impose international sanctions and depicted that the Iranians may be cheating. It is suspected that Iranians work for the enrichment of nuclear at unknown locations.

November

November 8th - A Tibetan Uprising began on 8 November 2018. Protestors marched to Chinese forces control point in east Tibet. On their way, 33 protestors were shot dead.

November 14th - The Thai government declared that Bangkok is under a serious threat of being submerged by the sea, due to the rising sea level and extreme ocean activity around the city.

November 18th - Protesters gathered around the City Hall of Bangkok, furiously accusing the government of failing to create proper policies for the protection of the capital. The citizens expressed that they do not wish to leave their homes, referred to the flood protection projects being conducted in Europe and asserted that those efforts should set an example for the Thai government.

December

December 1st - Oceanographer Ms. Caitlyn Srangiyong, a specialist on the effects of climate change in Southeast Asia, said that the oceanic activities are seriously irregular and dangerous around Bangkok. She added that this makes a total submerge date prediction impossible and pointed out that a great part of the city is already underwater. She also explained that the seawall projects and barriers used in Europe would not be efficient for Bangkok, since one of the great factors that led to this condition is the sinking of the ground the city is built on. She noted that the case is hopeless and a decent urban planning could only postpone the inevitable event.

December 12th - Ukraine warplanes shot down a Russian military aircraft on the border with Russian Federation. Vladimir Putin immediately called the Russian Army General to Kremlin. Following this meeting, the Spokesman of the Russian Federation said the Su-34 was hit by air-to-air missiles fired by Ukraine warplane while it was flying over Russian Federation territory. Also, he claimed that the Russian plane did not in any way threaten Ukraine. We will take necessary measures as soon as possible. On the other hand, Ukraine military officials said the aircraft was flying over Donetsk territory. NATO said that we were contact with Ukraine authorities.

December 15th - Dr. Equinne O'ne and his team managed to breed a human baby in a fully working artificial organic womb. The "wonder kid" male baby was named Orhoon Corey and weighed 7.1 pounds. Dr. O'ne stated that Corey is an epitome of hope for the humanity and that he symbolizes indefinite abilities of humans using science. 2019

January

January 5th- Operation Donetsk began on 5 January 2019. Over the course of the operation, about forty thousand Russian soldiers were deployed to Donetsk Region. In addition to troops, the Russians employed 200 tanks.

January 8th- Belarusian leader explicitly announced their aspiration to join EU by the end of 2025 and therefore applied for candidacy.

January 11th- Russian Federation launched their individual Space Station into the Low Earth Orbit.

January 15th- A research facility in North Russia (Norilsk), connected to the radical nationalist group Supreme Russian Front (SRP) was apprehended in an operation of the federal police. The Police stated that they were alarmed by a tip from a reliable source that the SRP was conducting ectogenesis procedures in a facility in Norilsk. 8 floors under the facility registered under a shell corporation, the Police found 600 artificial wombs containing 5-7 months old fetuses. 63 scientists linked to the SRP were taken into custody. The fetuses were transferred to an undisclosed laboratory for the delivery of the babies and their future adoption.

January 16th- Dr. Equinne O'neré and his team managed to breed a human baby in a fully working artificial organic womb. The “wonder kid” male baby was named Orhoon Corey and weighed 7.1 pounds. Dr. O'neré stated that Corey is an epitome of home for the humanity and that he symbolizes indefinite abilities of humans using science. Dr. O'neré continued that this achievement can spare parents from difficult, tiring and dangerous pregnancy processes and that females can sustain their regular lifestyles while their babies are growing in a safe and secure environment. The “ectogenesis pioneer” also predicted that this procedure will reduce the rate of

January 17th- Dr. Deriabura Iarikino from the Juntendo University of Tokyo and his team succeeded in creating the first man-made artificial womb comprised entirely of human cells. A rabbit fetus was incorporated into the womb, leading to the immediate death of the fetus after removal. The cause of death was reported as improper development of the internal system of the rabbit, which was caused by lack of necessary hormones. Dr. Iarikino stated that this team will carry out further research to improve the womb, the fertilization technique and the growth process of the fetus.

January 18th - Due to the global warming in Africa, where two-thirds of the world's cocoa is produced, chocolate has become as rare and expensive as caviar.

January 18th - The Russian Federation annexed some of the most important economic and agricultural areas of the Ukraine, mainly in Donetsk region.

January 19th - Russian forces captured the Donetsk Sergey Prokofiev International Airport.

January 20th - The President of United States of America, Donald J. Trump: *“We are concerned about Russia’s recent deployment of military forces to Donetsk. Russian military activities in Europe raise serious questions.”*

January 22th - The USA, European Countries, Australia, and Japan imposed sanctions against Russia after annexation of Donetsk from Ukraine. Abovementioned governments targeted financial sanctions and travel bans on those who have been instrumental in the Russian threat to Ukraine's sovereignty.

February

February 6th - Vladimir Putin said: *“According to a call made by Donetsk Republic, we used our ‘third party states right’ in that region. International community should understand that this is not an occupation.”*

February 11th - The Thai government published a report explaining that the population of Bangkok is decreasing day by day due to their citizens migrating to neighbor cities and countries because of the rising sea levels. The report mentions several canal and seawall projects that are currently going on, yet such efforts seem to fail to remove the source of the problem and provide an actual solution.

February 15th - The Ukrainian Government announced that they are not able to continue with the Ukrainian Wall due to the Russian attacks on their territorial integrity.

March

March 7th - President Vladimir Putin inked a deal in Moscow with Donetsk and Crimea leaders that officially makes Russia responsible for defending the self-declared republic, where the Russia

has stationed thousands of troops since a conflict in Ukraine. By terms of the agreement, any aggression by Ukraine against Donetsk and Crimea would be treated as an act of aggression against Russia. Also, the Contracting Parties shall conduct a coordinated foreign policy, which involves mutual interests of the Contracting parties in various fields of cooperation, informing each other of the committed action in this regard, as well as closely cooperate in promoting peace, stability and security in Donetsk and Crime Region.

March 9th- Annual Meeting of the New Champions, next generation of fast-growing enterprises shaping the future of business and society together with leaders from major multinationals as well as government, media, academia and civil society, convenes.

March 10th – *“The Russian defense treaty violates Ukraine sovereignty and territorial integrity and blatantly contradicts the principles of international law, OSCE principle. Also occupied regions of Donetsk are integral parts of Georgia, and we continue to support Ukraine’s independence sovereignty and territorial integrity”* NATO’s Secretary-General Herr Khut Øskagna said.

March 20th- The Chairman of the United States Government Space Program Jonathan Claire responded to the encouragement of several States on the issue of the regulation of space affairs. Chairman Claire stated that the United States of America stands at a much more sophisticated and evolved stage regarding space technologies, compared to the other nations of the world. The Chairman added that the United States is considering giving an affirmative answer regarding these efforts, although he stated that the United States of America shall not be evaluated on the equal grounds with nations that are still in the development stage regarding their extension into other

planets and space. It is expected that if the USA agrees to join the efforts on space affairs regulations, they will seek better and exclusive terms and privileges for themselves.

April

April 14th - Protests in China continued. 45 protestors died during clashes with police. The leader of Tibetan independence movement was arrested.

April 24th- Republicans in U.S. lashed out at Iran's rhetoric and ideology of 'Death to America'. Chairperson for New York State Senate Jemma Whitewater stated that the relations with Iran changed drastically as a result of the negotiations and the lift of the sanctions, it is not fundamentally different and in some areas still conflicting.

April 15th- Drugs are released that can switch off genes that cause the disease of Alzheimer.

April 20th - Lake Tanganyika, which was one of the African Great Lakes, and the second-largest lake in the world, disappeared from the map. This is having a devastating impact on Burundi, Tanzania, Zambia, and the Democratic Republic of Congo with 30 million people depending on the lake for agriculture, drinking water, livestock, fishing and other purposes. On the other hand, Famine and the second Angolan civil war have erupted as huge numbers of refugees attempt to flee the region.

May

May 3rd - Catalonia's pro-independence alliance won the election. Result of the election shows the pro-independence parties took 81 seats, a number enough for the mandate to seek secession from

Spain. The leader of the one of the most pro-independence party, Eduemre Raul Gonzalez said:

“Even though currently secession is not available under the constitution of Spain, these results have shown that Catalans may get themselves excluded from bear the economic burden of the whole of Spain.”

May 7th - After 20 years of discovering the first gene that increases the risk of Alzheimer, scientists identified 10 more specific genes, which provided the creation of targets to identify treatments. Colinfirth University’s Professor Mary Jane Cartwright stated: *“After the years of researches and trials, fortunately, we will be able to cut the risk of the developing disease by over 90% within a few years.”*

May 18th - British regulators helped Iran Banks come from the cold. The countries maintained a strong economic relationship driven by the trade. This has been a great advantage for Iran while exerting efforts to overcome sanctions legacy.

June

June 6th - The remaining Alevi militants in Damascus are starting to move south as the Sunni rebels in the southern region have the upper hand due to the US support. The Sunni front of the Syrian conflict is extending and the Alevis are irregularly positioning in Syria, with most of them headed North. Russia is still battling ISIS and Kurdish forces near the Turkish border and seems to have given up hope on the government supporters due to their weak status.

April 6th - Due to climate change, Asian rice fields faced with tragic drought. With the declining efficiency in these fields, 20 thousand farmers lost their jobs.

June 15th - 250 Citizens of the Donetsk Region tried to flee to the Ukraine. 14 were shot dead by the pro-Russian militants.

June 22nd - The USA government spoke against the wall built by Russia stating that they are claiming territories they do not have a right on and that they are destroying the concept of territorial integrity.

June 23th - Turkey and Greece have agreed on a mutual action plan to stem the flood of refugees and migrants from Turkey to European Union.

July

July 10th - Ukrainian forces fought with separatists in the city of Donetsk. Three Ukrainian helicopters mounted a heavy attack on the rebel-held international airport terminal at Donetsk firing rockets and throwing out decoy flares as militants shot at them from the ground.

July 22 - The World Health Organization classifies Model UN activities as “a disease”.

August

August 23th - Under political pressure from the United States, Europe and Russian Federation, separatists and the Ukrainian Government have been taking steps toward normalizing their relations. They agreed to cease-fire in Donetsk Region.

August 30th- Over 600.000 people have crossed the Mediterranean Sea to seek shelter in Greece. The Greek Authorities and the European Institutions are alarmed and worried about the border control and internal security. The remaining EU Countries are considering strengthening their border control regulations.

September

September 10th - Last night, the Russian Federation deployed an additional group 10.000 troops, 3.000 tanks and 6.000 construction workers in Donetsk. Ukrainian forces were caught unprepared and outmanned before the pro-Russian groups led by the Donetsk People's Republic. The Ukrainian forces were evacuated from East Donetsk and the Russian workers started to dig a line of ditches diving the Donetsk Region.

September 12th- Battles continue in Donetsk as Russia keeps supporting the pro-Russian fighters with personnel and equipment. The estimated death toll is 890 fighters and 320 civilians. Nations are alarmed and trying to figure out the intention of the Russian Federation behind this immediate and severe action.

September 13th- The UN COPUOS released a two-year schedule for the preparation process before Tokyo Conference on the Peaceful Usage of Space. The program includes important topics to be discussed in the ordinary sessions of the Legal Subcommittee and stages for national legislative bodies to get their regulations in conformation with such a treaty.

September 14th- Hit maker country-dubstep artist Lil' drop Grocery released her "Valentine's Day exclusive" single; "Stripped From Egos".

September 17th- The humpback whales are declared extinct by the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF). The Fund was expecting the extinction of the species in a much farther date. Officials have announced that these events were the result of extraordinary draughts and immense heat waves that affected Africa. The horrifying images of the dead animals are violently graphic. The WHO warns the local governments for the disposal of the dead animals, since they can lead to serious infections.

September 19th- It is disclosed that Russia is taking advantage from the financial problems of the Ukrainian Government and building a "Great Russian Wall" cutting Donetsk in half. President Vladimir Putin declared; *"It was time that we show the strength of our nation against the disrespectful approach taken by the Ukrainian government. Now, East Donetsk and its Russian people will be able to live among us, without an allegedly "Great" Wall that separates them from their brothers and sisters."*


October

October 5th - Brazil hosted minor protests. Economically less-developed cities are the main areas that the said protests take place. The Dynamic Brazilian Youth Collaboration Army(DBYC-A) movements organized an attack against police forces. As a result of attack, six police officers died.

October 9th- 3.000 refugees striving to reach the Greek mainland were captured and sent back to the island.

November

November 9th - Russia permanently closed the border between East and West Donetsk. They used barbed wire fencing and armed guards. The Leader of pro-Russian militants said that people attempting to escape East Donetsk were shot on sight. The Russian Donetsk Wall included: 99 miles of fencing, nearly 450 watchtowers, 120 bunkers and 65 miles of anti-vehicle trenches. The construction site for the Ukrainian Wall seems to be under the Russian control, falling behind the Russian Wall now.



November 10th- The German Government encourages the European Union to hold a summit for a discussion on the suspension of the Schengen Agreement. The country is concerned for their future security and sovereignty.

November 22nd- Famous American novelist George R. R. Martin, best known for the series of Game of Thrones, died in a tragic plane crash. The members of scenario team of the TV series and HBO show runners David Benioff and Dan Weiss who were the only people who knew the end of the series, were in the plane as well. There were not any survivors. The sixteenth forthcoming novel of Martin, The Winds of Death was not complete yet. Besides millions of readers and fans of the TV show, US, UK and Iceland had declared one day of national mourning. Because of the sudden decrease in the stock market values of HBO and Time Warner Inc., U.S. stock market had faced an alarming fluctuation.

December

December 2th - Colonel Herr Khut Øskagna is appointed to NATO as the Secretary-General.

December 12th- The FDA allowed an artificial womb trial on a human fetus for only a span of 14 days for Cornell University's Dr. O'neere.

December 27th- Iran ranked 56th in the World Economic Forum's 2019-2020 Global Competitiveness Index. The 'Transport Infrastructure' was the particular pillar which found a room for growth. The Western Companies especially the British and French rushed to Iranian goods for cars, planes, and metals.

December 30th- The United States of America held a national conference on Space Studies and the current international approach. The participants coming from different Space Organizations suggested the establishment of an International Space Court.

2020

January

January 3rd- The second stage of the Netherlands Flood Prevention Project is completed. The shoreline of the flood-threatened country is now protected by concrete walls and beach nourishment. Officials are hoping that the project will be sufficient to prevent great floods that were predicted to occur in the near future.

January 4th - More than 50 people escaped from East Donetsk to West Donetsk. On the other hand, 23 people were shot dead by the pro-Russian border patrol.

January 4th- A Chinese computer passes the Turing Test. The test is judged by a human, who conducts an online natural language conversation with a computer and a human. The judge was not able to distinguish the two. It was reported that this marks the highest level reached in the field of artificial intelligence.

January 8th - In the Tibet Trials, carried out by the People's Republic China, a rebellion local leader was found guilty. After this decision, China executed the local leader by hanging. Internet access is now also banned in Tibet.

January 10th - The US-based International Campaign for Tibet told that there are currently at least 1000 known political prisoners in Tibet. Chinese actions in Tibet were breaches of Human Rights.

January 12th- The Russian Wall is being enforced and fortified. President Putin spoke to the media and stated their conviction on the establishment of this line.

January 15th- The Union the Naciones Suramericanas (Union of the South American Nations- UNASUR) Secretary-General Diego Rianza spoke about the recent developments in the space technologies research programs; “We are proud that our nations are collaborating with one of the biggest space related institutions of the world, NASA. I believe that these events will allow us to keep track of the furthest level of civilization. As we are confident that we are strong contributors to this area of science and that we will soon be also active in space, we are very eager to be involved in the meetings regarding the regulation of space usage.

January 16th - Angolan Armed Forces were preparing for a large-scale operation against separatist militants in Lunda Norte region.

January 17th - A protest that approximately 4000 people attended occurred near the government building in Bogota. The Police manage to scatter the crowd by using force.

January 18th - The harsh response of the Police boomeranged and brought about much larger public protest. Much larger crowd gathered to protest the government.

January 18th- The United States Government agreed to host a conference in order to draft an agreement for the usage of space.

January 19th- The war in Syria is being reshaped. While the ISIS forces and the Kurdish Government supporters still remain in very few spots throughout Syria, the majority of the said

forces are located along the Turkish border battling with Turkish and Russian forces. Meanwhile, the rebel forces that managed to diminish the strength of the Kurdish and the ISIS do not seem to get along within each other. As some Sunni oriented groups that once joined the government supporters are merging with the Sunni rebels located in South Syria, the Deir ez-Zor oriented and Alevis rebel forces are left without support. This new division is mostly evident around Hama, Aleppo and Latakia.

January 21st - 24 years old Antonio Miguel Rodriguez was killed by unknown people. It is thought that the reason of the homicide is Antonio's tweets supporting FARC's violent activities.

February

February 6th - According to report of the US Geological Survey, there is %30 of the world's undiscovered and 13% of oil waiting to be found inside the Arctic Circle. Oil Companies of United States America started drilling the undisputed zone of US.

February 10th - A group of soldier from National Army of Colombia killed 15 FARC militants in a rural place close to Medellin.

February 15th - A bombing attack was realized in the square of Medellin. 263 people died. The strike was claimed by FARC.

February 20th - Public protest was diffused to the country, and the president was held responsible for the deaths in recent weeks since he leads negotiations with FARC.

February 22nd- Several Countries declare level 7 emergency on climate; shut down establishments thought as danger to the protection and preservation of clean air. cities in member states such as PRC, USA, Japan, and TR are planned to be evacuated due to heavy pollution and emergency cases of poisoning. It is reported that in some of the cities, the sun almost doesn't shine or even seen.

February 25th- The World Health Organization (WHO) increased the alarm phase for the disease of Model UN from Phase 4 to Phase 5.

February 27th - The Police's attitudes, using proportional force towards the public is highly criticized and responded aggregate by the public and the international community.

March

March 4th - Battle of Jarabulus has continued between the Kurdish Forces (YPG) and IS. With support from Russia, the YPG was trying to capture land between Jarabulus and Azaz, Turkey officials said that: YPG is taking areas for its own that were taken from Isis with help of US airstrikes. Therefore, we will take necessary measures as soon as possible.

March 6th - The Leader of Chile Space Agency said that Chile spends US\$65 million every year on space products and on using other foreign-built satellites. Also he attached that a properly developed space program could save the country a lot of money. *"From hence, I am very happy to announce that we are preparing our space station. We aim to launch it as soon as possible."*

March 15th- An Alevi group coming from North Syria marched into the Latakia Russian Air Base to use the facility as storage and a base for their operations. The Hezbollah oriented and Assad

supporting group is deteriorating as various groups are leaving to join other sides due to the successful strikes of the US air forces. Although, the new blocs being shaped within the rebel side may give the upper hand to the government supporters if the fight between the Alevis and the Sunnis grow farther in Latakia. The lack of unification may have created a chance of victory for the Hezbollah yet the severe damages suffered from the previous attacks have corrupted the government bloc from inside and members started to leave to join the Alevis or the Sunni.

March 18th - A corruption scandal erupted in Brazil. According to the tapes, the President and the minister of settlement get commissions from Camargo Correa per tender that the company wins.

March 20th - Combining with the ongoing protests of the Police and occurred security problems as a result of it, the corruption scandal showed the fact the lifespan of Temer's presidency is not so long.

March 22nd - With the leadership of Democratic Labor Party, some center-left parties released a joint statement, calling the jurisdiction to do what is necessary and the public the show their reaction.

March 23rd - Kurdish Forces (YPG) controlled 30 percent of Jarabulus. At least 80 ISIS fighters were killed since YPG's offensive began on Jarabulus on March 4, the Syrian Observatory reported. Turkey has accused the Kurdish militia of pursuing "demographic change" in northern Syria by forcibly displacing Turkmen and Arab communities.

April

April 2nd - The Supreme Court was convened for Temer's case of impeachment and the case started hearing. Temer advocated that the tapes were installation. Thereupon, a group of IT specialist were arranged to analyze the tapes whether they are real or installation.

April 7th - In order to create an ISIL free zone, Turkey and the United States have agreed on a military action plan with objective of clearing the Turkish-Syrian border of jihadist terrorists.

April 20th - The special driver of the CEO of Camargo Correa, Jose Fernando Leite de Souza gave a testimony saying that he witnessed some phone calls between the CEO and the President.

April 23rd - By the dawn on April 23, Turkish land operation against ISIL and YPG began. Turkish forces consisted of around 25.000 troops.

April 24th - Public smoking is banned across all states of the USA.

October 26th - JK Rowling's new book, a prequel to the Harry Potter series, telling the story of how Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry was found, comes out. The book stays on top of the New York Times Best Seller List for 120 consecutive weeks.

April 28th - The Climate Group announced that the oil reserves will get further exposed as a side effect of the global warming. The Group called upon States seeking oil, for them to stop acting as pragmatists and focus on the greater problem. The Officials from Climate Change stressed that if the world does not stop prioritizing their near-future interests, there will be no far future to enjoy short-living successes.

April 30th - Switzerland abandons nuclear energy as they shut down their latest nuclear plant.

Polar cold sweeps over North America. Over 4,500 flights have been cancelled in the US thus far. Some states recorded lowest temperatures, North Carolina as low as -16 degrees Celsius, breaking its historic record of -14 in 2014 and -12 in 1884. In Montana and Saskatchewan, 87 have been reported frozen to death.

May

May 4th - The tension increased in the Middle East. Turkish forces captured the city of Jarabulus, which has been occupied by ISIL forces, to create buffer zone for the purpose of sending refugees to that zone. With this development, Israel has asserted that chaos shall cease to exist.

May 14th - Putin : *“Our military is doing heroic work against terrorism in Syria. NATO forces were shielding Islamic State terrorists from Russian attacks. Every state should be respect sovereignty of Syria. Also, Syria had a right to defend its territory and airspace.”* In response to operations of Turkish forces, Russia sends artillery and tanks to Syria as part of continued military buildup.

May 18th - A new mobile communication company from Japan, Abinapi Yosunuzya, releases the first smartphone with an interface that converts brain signals into digital texts. 3.600 people were in line for the first batch of the product. Two were killed in the stampede after the opening of the doors in Tokyo. The CEO of the company expressed their pride on this new technology and asserted that with wearable headpieces or lenses, this could lead into a digital form of telepathy.

May 20- Kanye West officially announced his candidacy for the United States Presidential Elections of 2020 by a selfie taken with the possible First Lady Kim Kardashian West.

May 20th - What de Souza stated in his testimony and the result of the IT group's analysis overlapped and it became certain that Temer made corruption. In the light of these data, the President was impeached.

May 24th- Kim Kardashian West is in her 4th and reportedly final pregnancy, expecting twins. In an interview, she states that she will be fulfilling her wish to have her own Kardashian-West clan.

June

June 6th- People's Republic of China placed the "Tiangong Space Station" in the Low Earth Orbit. The Chinese Government Declaration on Tiangong Space Station words that: *"The Tiangong Space Station is a great achievement for our nation. We are pleased that we will be able to enhance our knowledge and abilities on the rules of the universe through conducting various free fall experiments and discover numerous unknowns about the space."*

June 10th - Due to military coup in Democratic Republic of the Congo, one of the most powerful states of Africa, Angola, interfered with the situation in Congo by the reason of rounding out domestic disturbances of her neighboring country. As results of intervention, approximately 560 people died.

June 18th- ISIS fighters and their supporters are moving towards North for backup, where the majority of their men is battling with the forces of Russia and Turkey. Deir ez-Zor is being partially abandoned and the alevi rebels are getting stronger in the said region. The Kurdish Government is still active near the Turkish border.

July

July 14th - 2 million Refugees in Turkey were placed in Jarabulus camps of refugees. Security of the camps are provided by Turkish Soldiers.

July 16th - The Supreme Leader of Iran, Ali Khamenei (81) died from cancer. As his predecessor Assembly of Experts chose Cemra Akhzu who is known by his reformist views.

July 25th - The Catalan Parliament has voted the legislative proposal, which was suggested by Catalonia's pro-independence alliance, on the issue of Catalonia's independence vote. The legislative proposal passed.

August

August 2nd - Because of the impeachment, Brazilian people went to the polls. The center-left group led by Democratic Labor Party gained momentum beginning from the statement. The enlarged gap between social classes was considered as a result of government's opening door to private sector unequivocally. Moreover, the corruption scandal makes an impression of that the executives only seek to fill their pockets.

August 5th - A new uprising came from the Russian side of the Donetsk Wall. A newly formed group protested the Wall stating that it was not a border but solely a wall. The protestors demanded to reach their loved ones across the wall.

August 8th - Refugees are running away from the floods in Bangladesh as neighboring countries, especially a highly populated country India is having border problems. Humanitarian assistance is

needed in the area. Bangladesh needs serious attention since the agricultural fields at the shores are destroyed by sea salt.

August 10th - A leftist coalition with 4 parties, consisting of Democratic Labor Party-the leading party-, Brazilian Socialist Party, Workers' Party and Socialist People's Party entered the elections and won it by taking 70% of the votes. Carlos Lupi, the president of Democratic Labor Party became the President of Brazil.

August 22nd- The 14-day artificial womb trial with a human fetus was conducted by Dr. O'Nere, who is recently acknowledged by various scientists as a 21st century pioneer for ectogenesis. Dr. O'Nere stated that they managed to create a composition that could function as placenta and that they upgraded their previous womb prototypes with one providing sufficient oxygen and waste disposal for the growth of a human fetus. He expressed the hopes of their team on the removal of legal obstacles and that they are ready for a full trial on a human fetus.

*August 25th- The Syrian War continues with ISIS and the Kurdish groups battling Turkey and partially Russia along the Turkish Border. Russia seems to be slowly taking their support back due to the weakening of the Assad regime and their controversial relationship with Turkey. Although, it is not likely that Russia will leave their base in Latakia.

September

September 10th- The final stage of the Netherlands Flood Prevention Project has begun with the city of Amsterdam. The Project Coordinator Rick Costra asserted that the historical value of the city will always be their priority and they only plan to elevate the housing and business premises, since the project focuses on the protection of property and persons. Mr. Costra explained that the

historical buildings are strong enough to survive floods but they will also be enforced for the cases of extreme circumstances.

January 13th- Artificial Intelligence is now used for the scanning of human behavior, expressions and brain waves. As the technology comes closer to the point of mind reading the detection of criminal intent and perfect scanning of crime scenes are possible.

January 15th- Space Debris has tripled from its amount in 2011.

September 20th - Russia has decided to deploy five thousand Russian troops and two nuclear missiles, to Latakia, the principal port city of Syria. After this decision, Spokesman of United States of America told to the press that: “Russia played fast and loose like North Korea. With this step, Russia fanned the flame of Middle East. Additionally, conflicts in Latakia still continue. Therefore, a huge security gap is in existence in that region.”

October

October 10th - About five thousand Russian troops were deployed to Latakia Russian Air Base. In addition to troops, the Russians employed 50 tanks in order to protect nuclear missiles.

October 21th- An underground food mafia was formed in the streets of Balgat, Ankara. The dangerous entity called Arrogant Ravioli Squad started looting walnut storages around Ankara due to an undiscovered objective.

November

November 1st - The refugees in Euboia have attacked a town in the island, in order to take their homes. The refugees are complaining that the detention centers are too small for the large group of refugees in the island.

November 2nd - The President of Colombia, Juan Manuel Santos Calderon expressed that he will not let any public disorder in this critical days that the country has been experiencing, and the Police's behavior will continue as same as it is until the order is maintained.

November 5th - Apple announces collaboration with NASA. Withdraws from phone industry. All iPhone users protest against the decision.

November 9th - One year ago, The Donetsk Wall was built. Five people had been arrested on the suspicion of espionage in East Donetsk. These people were executed by hanging on the famous square of Donetsk.

November 10th - The protest in Colombia streets, cities did not stop. Controversially, it enlarged. Besides, the opposition to the President's policies is scaling up within the National Army of Colombia.

November 15th - The Spokesman of the Russian Federation told that: We try to prevent the conflict by building a wall in Donetsk. The Russia had responded to the Donetsk peoples' cry for help. Our purpose was clear: to protect Donetsk Civilians.

November 16th - The Hezbollah and Assad regime activity in the Latakia province is decreasing as the number of Alevi and Sunni fighters increase. The Latakia region is now one of the most disputed areas in Syria and hosts battles between the Alevis and the Sunni.

November 19th - In the “Tibet Trial”, held by China, the leader of the Tibetan independence movement was found guilty by the reason of instigating a revolt and sentenced to death by firing squad.

December

December 5th - The tension increased in Congo. After annexation of Congo, Angola controlled some of the most important economic areas, especially diamond reserves of the Congo.

December 7th - NASA reported that the ISS was hit by a piece of a space rocket that previously exploded in 2008. The communication system of the Station was severely damaged and needs immediate attention. The crew inside of the Station is safe and the USA is preparing to send a crew for backup.

December 10th – A security point of China in Tibet, was attacked by unidentified person or persons. As a result of the attack, six Chinese policemen died.

December 12th - Tension rises within Thailand, due to the internal migration of Bangkok citizens. The Bangkok Municipality Official said that the city is not financially able to conduct appropriate

prevention projects for the prevention of the sinking of the city. The official added that the city is practically doomed and a new urban planning for the replacement of Bangkok citizens and the recovery of the property is urgent.

December 14th - Angola made a deal with Russian and Chinese companies. According to the agreement, Angola government decide to give a mining license and petroleum exploration license to Russian and Chinese mining and oil companies.. On the other hand, Three Chinese companies have secured contracts in Angola to build more than military establishments in six provinces of the country for around US\$750 million, according to presidential orders.

December 25th - About 1200 Iranian troops were deployed to Latakia Russian Air Base for the purpose of protecting nuclear missiles.

2021

January

January 7th- The longest drought that the world has witnessed in the 21st century has today noted as the draught in Namibia with the Sub-Saharan country suffering from lack of rain since 4 years and 6 months now. This has been recorded as the longest drought in a civilized area with static.

January 10th - A military coup was realized by the leadership of General Jaime Alfonso Lasprilla Villamizar, the Commander of the Colombian National Army. The public welcomed the coup positively because of the opposition towards FARC. There were also the allegations about cheating on 2020 elections.

January 11th - Lasprilla met with an officer from Central Intelligence Agency in Bogota.

January 18th- The Juntendo University declared that they are in the final stage of preparation for a full ectogenesis trial on a human fetus. Taking both domestic and international studies into account, the Japan Family Planning Association expressed their support and hope for the results of said trial.

January 29th- NASA has signed more than 50 agreements with 20 Latin American countries. According to agreements, Latin American space scientists will be trained by NASA in the United States. Some of the included countries are enumerated as; Chile, Cuba, Brazil, Argentina, Dominican Republic, Mexico. It is likely that the training will first result with a collaborative product as a joint Space Station or a Space Program. The main objective behind such agreements is the proper development of Latin America's space technologies.

January 20th- The Bridge of the Horns is completed. The transcontinental bridge that connects Africa to Middle East comes with a 29 km highway and sustainable energy support. The project cost 200 billion U.S. dollars but it is expected to create commercial and touristic advantages.

January 25th - On 25 February 2021 at 06:05:31, Latakia Russian Air Base were attacked by the northern rebels. The Group captured the Latakia military base due to power vacuum of base. Nuclear missiles in the military base have been detonated. After the explosion of the nuclear missile, great nuclear fallout occurred in the city of Latakia. Additionally, it is expected that the nuclear fallout may affect the neighboring countries, Turkey and Lebanon to a certain extent.

Currently the most crucial issue is in Latakia and its close surroundings. Including approximately 9000 Russian Soldiers, 250.000 people died.

October 21st - 20% of the city of Venice is declared to have gone underwater. Venice-oriented groups are furious as the government and demand further and better action to be taken for the sake of their city.

October 22nd - A forty-three (43) years old woman living in the suburban regions of the Russian city Nizhny Novgorod has been hospitalized with severe abdominal pain, mild hallucinations, high fever and a general condition of physical and mental weakness which includes lack of appetite and lack of energy. The name of the patient is Pitosina Ekaterina (Katya) Yaroslavovna. She does not have a history of any genetic weaknesses running through her family that may have caused a disease with such symptoms according to her statements given to the doctors. Ms. Yaroslavovna is known as a literature teacher in a high school close to the city center. According to the information given to the doctors by herself, she is married and has two kids which one of them is a student in the high school she is currently teaching in.

January 23rd - The patient has expressed her intense pain increasing in her abdomen, head and neck regions. At a certain point during her hospitalization (4th day) Ms. Yaroslavovna committed a failed suicide attempt in order to, in her own words, “relieve herself from the intolerable pain”.

With increased doses of morphine and combined pain killers the patient seemed to return to a stable condition by the end of the 5th day, however barely conscious.

October 26th- The government of Netherlands expressed concerns about the refugee problem initiated from the coast of Greece. The country, dealing with crucial natural problems due to the sea level rise is struggling to manage their internal migration problem.

February

February 1st - United Nations Security Council held an emergency meeting after the explosion of the nuclear missile in Syria. The representative of United Kingdom said that the situation in Syria is very critical. Following this, representative of United States of America told that; “It is imperative that we immediately send our expert team to Turkey and Lebanon for the purpose of diminishing the effects of the nuclear fallout. The groups that carried out this attack have already been in our list of recognized terrorist organizations. Thus, our second action should be focusing on an immediate solution for countering the activity of this organization. If there is an intentional nature behind this triggering that will necessitate that we comprehend that we are approaching a malicious entity. On the other side, the Russian Minister of Foreign Affairs told that our military base in Latakia came under attack on 25 January 2021 and suggested that they are given a temporary mandate over the area. We believe that the focus should be on the warring groups within Syria and not the control of the area that no human would dare to enter. The future losses caused by neglected nuclear fallout could easily amount to unprecedented human lives and a chaotic and unsafe environment. Contacting Turkey and Lebanon and trying to get a hold of the status quo will be important. An immediate plan for the evacuation of the area and the delivery of proper aid to the victims should be our subsequent action.”

February 1st - Nearly to the 10th day of her hospitalization, the patient has suddenly started to suffer kidney failure. The doctors have reported that the high doses of drug intake were definitely

a factor in this unfortunate development however they are almost certain that the disease has its own effects in this case, also. The patient is now dependent to a dialyzer. It has been stated by the chief physician of the hospital that they are deeply concerned about further potential organ failures. He also added that this disease does have unprecedented effects and does not bear a resemblance to any common diseases in the region and they are not even certain at the time being that, whether the disease is caused by bacterial or viral infections.

February 2nd - Various yet fatal symptoms threaten the patient's life, and in order to examine the mysterious progress of the disease laboratory research has been started and the results of pathological investigation are expected for further treatment of the disease whereas the condition of the patient is getting worse every passing day.

February 4th – Turkish Military launched an operation against the remaining ISIS forces in Tall Tamr and Tell Beydar in Syria. The ISIS militants were easily captured.

February 5th -Turkey declared a state of emergency in Hatay region. On the other hand, Lebanon declared a state of emergency throughout the country.

February 6th - In order to control the disputed region, Lunda Norte, the Heavy fighting between the pro-Congo militants and Angolan Armed Forces continued. To date, more than 60.000 people had died and over 200.000 had been internally displaced.

February 8th - Approximately 80 percent of The People of Damascus left the city.

February 11th - After the military coup in Colombia, operations towards FARC extremely increased and it once again turned into a civil war.

February 19th- Greenland is in the preparation of a draft proposing a referendum on full independence. The government of Denmark reacted by stating that Greenland is already at a very advantageous position, since they have sovereignty over the vast majority of areas that can come to mind. Denmark believes that Greenland will always benefice from the support of Denmark and it will be extremely difficult to sustain the economy with the very low population of Greenland.

February 22nd - Some news agencies connected to Westerners claimed the existence of close relations between FARC and Brazilian Government.

February 23rd- Rebels are avoiding positioning around Latakia. The battle between the southern and the northern groups are still continuing, especially in Deir ez-Zor. Conflicts in Idlib are also downgrading due to its close location to Latakia.

February 10th - Results of the pathology test have arrived and it was declared that the disease is caused by a bacterium. The initial tests show that the bacteria belong to the family Bacillaceae, and the genus of Bacillus. Although the symptoms of the disease do not match with most of the specific symptoms of the diseases caused by the bacteria of any of the species that belong to the same genus; its biological properties suggest that the bacterium belongs to the genus of “Bacillus”. Since it does not seem to belong to a specific species for the time being, the scientists have decided to call the bacterium “Bacillus Katyaensis” provisionally, using the name of the Patient Zero; although it should be noted that this naming do not bear any scientific value. The disease has started to be known as “Katya Disease” among the public. One last note added by the

pathology report is that, the bacteria seems to have traces in its cytoplasm and in its genetic material, that it may have been genetically modified.

February 28th- China has completed the construction of the largest solar thermal farm of 2,000 megawatts in Shaanxi. The plant is a product of American-Chinese cooperation. With the recent construction, China has increased the installed solar energy capacity to 21 gigawatts. China has been investing heavily in solar energy and alternative energy resources since mid-2000s to meet her ever-growing energy demand.

March

March 4th - Two more people in Nizhny Novgorod have been hospitalized due to similar complaints given by Ms. Yaroslavovna and the three of the patients are immediately quarantined considering a possibility of an epidemic. Ms. Yaroslavovna is now called as “Patient Zero” and her blood tests are of utmost importance as the progress of the disease is on a much further point in her case.

March 5th- Due to global warming, the Arctic is now free of ice during the whole span of October.

March 9th- The USA Secretary of Defense addressed the Russian Government; “While Russia is claiming rightful sovereignty over the Ukrainian region trapped by the Donetsk Wall, they are also not allowing the wall to function as a two-way border that we all have around our rightful territories. It is time that Russia stops this contradiction and recognizes the right of Ukraine. If they want to embrace their alleged brothers and sisters, they can host them in the actual Russian land.

March 14th - Norway signed a commercial treaty with Shell Oil Company. According to agreement, two drill vessels of Shell Oil Company is sent to Norway coast for oil exploration.

March 15th- Russian intelligence ship sailed near drill vessels of Shell oil company.

March 24th - Shell drill vessels left the Norway Coast after oil exploration ends.

March 26th - Bashar al-Assad left his country and fled to Russia

March 24th- Victims of the Syrian nuclear explosion are under an evacuation process towards a buffer zone created by Turkey.

December 26th- The Department of Defense of the United States declared that they are initiating a Training and Equipment Program regarding the conflict of Syria. The Secretary of Defense, Clark James Terrence said; *“We do not believe in the legitimacy of the groups currently battling in Syria. Yet, as pioneer sponsors of the idea of democracy the United States will take the matters at their hands in order to create a safe zone in the Syrian land for the establishment of the proper regime. With refusing any direct connections with any of the groups in Syria, we will train the moderate supporters of the Free People of Syria in order to enhance their progress in front of the vicious attacks of the opposition. We believe that the Sunni are fighting for the good cause, considering that they have been created by the reaction against the former dictator Assad. Thus, we will stand together with the ones fighting against totalitarian and brutal regimes.”*

March 27th- The Thai government is considering moving the capital of the country from Bangkok to a northern city. The idea is found radical and extreme by a majority of the population. The Bangkok Municipality responded; “ The importance of Bangkok does not only come from it being a capital. This is a commercially important city, which is also filled with invaluable history. We will not give up on Bangkok. We are expecting the help of the nation for the construction of a great seawall, which will especially protect our agriculturally important premises.”

March 28th - Newest symptom in patient zero is labored breathing and visual impairment. Also, local scars have occurred and there is a considerable decrease in the speed of recovery from open wounds.

March 30th - Eight new patients have arrived at the hospital, making the total count of patients 11. It was noted by the physicians that 7 of the patients are from the same high school that Ms. Yaroslavovna works in. This clearly supported the idea that the disease may be a contagious one. The high school and the surrounding buildings have been evacuated and people who were nearby have been quarantined.

April

April 10th - The number of the people who have the disease has increased to 28 and consequently the Ministry of Healthcare of Russia (Minzdrav) declared a full control over the situation. After an increased and intense investigation, the disease is found to be spreading airborne and through rodents. A high ranking officer from the Minzdrav has stated that they are currently searching for a treatment as well as a vaccine. Vaccine would be helping the prevention and protection efforts whereas a treatment of the illness itself could be beneficial for the already ill 28 patients. Also, security forces have started an investigation near the quarantine zones and the high school.

April 15th - P5 states, upon the request of USA and People's Republic of China, collectively made a call to all sides warring in Syria in order to gather at Geneva on 6 May. It seems that the tragedy in Syria must have created a dramatic influence. The countries will gather in the United States and sit with the representatives of the battling groups in Syria. It is expected that the United States will strive to negotiate terms favoring the Southern rebels through arguing their victimization regarding the nuclear explosion.

August 6th - Turkey addresses the European concerns on the refugees stating that the Turkish government is living up to their commitments in delivering housing and humanitarian aid to the Syrian victims. Turkey also called the European States to take matters at their hands and actively contribute to the international efforts on the healing of the victimized Syrians.

April 23th - With the supports of United States led-coalition air strikes, Turkish forces eased the conflict the city of Deir ez-Zor of Syria. The remaining ISIS forces were completely wiped out. It is alleged that the Alevis forces in the dispute were temporarily supporting the ISIS forces in order to get the Sunni out of the region.

April 24th - The clashes between the separatist militants and Angolan Armed forces continue. Angola officials said that the army now in "full control" of the one of the largest mining area in Lunda Norte province.

April 25th - MUNers Without Borders (MWB) / Des MUNeres Sans Frontières (MSF) was established. On behalf of the MWB, an experienced MUNer Mr. Daia Buúra Yarquin highlighted in his statement; *"We will help MUNers worldwide where the need is greatest in Crisis*

Committees, cavities in the Rules of Procedure, conflicts in Final Document Drafting... We will carry MUN aid to wherever needed!"

April 29th- Samsung Galaxy X was released by. The device had a built-in projector that allows hologram phone calls which was the first of its kind.

May

May 6th- The United Nations Security Council held a session on the issue of Latakia. The Council adopted that the area including Latakia and its surroundings should be immediately evacuated with the support of the military if it becomes necessary. The area was not claimed by any states due to the disastrous environment going on and the battling rebel groups. It was decided that a buffer zone would be created in Turkey, in order for the temporary placement of the explosion victims. It was decided that the members would lift all sieges on conflicted and crucial areas and suspend their attacks for the facilitation of the delivery of humanitarian aid to the affected.

May 15th - Known as the Extreme Left Winger Group, DBYC-A (Dynamic Brazilian Young Cooperation - Army) destroyed Christ the Redeemer (Statue) in Rio de Janeiro, stating that it represents the abuse of religion and does not form a solution to the poverty problem of Brazilian people.

June

June 24th - The Catalonia independence referendum resulted in an 83%-17% victory for the Yes side. Whether Catalonia became the new European State will be determined through recognitions.

June 28th - The widespread usage of Artificial Intelligence leads companies into downsizing and terminating the employment of their administrative staff. “Virtual Employees” are replacing humans in service-based jobs and call centers. Even though the unemployment issue is growing due to these developments, the modern world benefits from high-speed, wireless technologies that provide a great drawback in paper usage.

July

July 4th - The 2021 Catalonia declaration of independence was adopted on 4 July 2021 by the representatives of the Catalonia People. The participants unanimously declared Catalonia to be independent from Spain. In response to this, Spain’s Prime Minister told that according to their constitution, the legality of the declaration is extremely disputable. The Spain's Constitution does not foresee the right to self-determination for any part of the country. On the other hand, the leader of the most powerful pro-independence party of Catalonia and also the first Prime minister of Catalonia, Eduemre Raul Gonzalez, stated that many Catalans do not consider themselves Spanish but exclusively Catalan. In this regard, Government of Spain was called upon respect for Catalonia’s self-determination movement. Mr. Gonzales concluded by asserting that: “Today, democracy won.”

July 11th - The United States of America government sent search and rescue and medical care teams specializing in nuclear incidents to the Latakia port in order.

July 16th - The Prime Minister of Netherlands, Alwin Grant told the media that the Netherlands Flood Prevention Project started to show insufficiencies as expected. Mr. Grant stated that global warming is expanding at an accumulating speed and that the world shall come together to solve the problem than leaving States alone for their efforts in individual redemptions.

July 20th - Catalans started to draft intricate plans to establish the region's own diplomatic service, central bank, tax authority and armed forces in the next 18 months.

July 22nd - Russian Federation deployed 200,000 additional forces around the Donetsk region. Alarmed by the sudden Russian military deployment Dennis Eichtvogel stated "This is an act of aggression; this is a threat to European borders. Russia must size her activities immediately." Russian officials remain silent on the matter.

August

August 4th - Minzdrav has issued a report which states: "Our latest research on the field and on the Katya disease itself have revealed many new information that supports a certain thesis that the bacteria can be the result of an effort of genetic modifying. Our interest in the thesis is at high

levels and we still do not intend to accept any foreign medical personnel however we will be sharing the data of the bacterium with the international authorities.”

August 6th- The Spanish Government issued a press release expressing that they are not recognizing the illegal secession of Catalonia. The Government stresses the point that Spain is not the enemy of the will of their people, yet as a state of law they will always prioritize the rule of law before anything. Thus, the Spanish Government requires a lawful method to be followed by the Catalans for them to reach independence.

August 12th- The Russian Government congratulated Catalonia, officially recognizing them as the new State in Europe. The message was delivered to the Catalonian Government with the following message; *“The Russian Federation stands with the cause of the Catalonian people and congratulates them for their great achievement. Thank you for proving to the world, once again, that the free will of the people will always prevail!”*

August 18th- President of Germany, Dennis Eichtvoegel addressed the situation in Spain; *“It is a sad period of time in Europe, as we see. Walls being built, people being slaughtered and nations being divided. We must see beyond the artificial objectives of individual actions and come together as a Union once again to achieve a collective success. Let us remind you that law will always stand as the key to peace and order and unlawful actions, regardless of how noble they are, cannot be favoured.”*

September

September 14th- Approximately 70.200 victims from the Latakia Province are receiving medical treatment in the Buffer Zone in Turkey. A vast majority is suffering from severe burns caused by thermal radiation. Various Medical Aid Groups and volunteers, coordinated by the Turkish Red Crescent are serving on site. The Head of the Executive Board of the Turkish Red Crescent stated that the medical teams were very successful to apply immediate care to the victims, in order to ease the pain and comfort them for the time being. Although, everyone is worried about the prospective health status of the victims, since they were exposed to radiation.

September 18th- The Government of Portugal published a press release supporting the central government of Spain and encouraging the Catalonian Region to follow the Spanish Constitution.

September 25th- Switzerland officially recognized the Catalonian Government. President of the Swiss Confederation noted that the public international law should prevail over the domestic norms that regulate internal affairs. The right of self-determination was favoured by the usually neutral country, basing on the fact that liberal approaches should be taken in times of doubt and controversy.

October

October 4th - 13 well known and respected health institutions from all around the world have carried an investigation on Bacillus Katyaensis and 6 of the institutions have decided that there is no strong evidence of a genetic modifying whereas 5 of the institutions have stated that the bacteria is most probably genetically modified and 2 of the institutions have declared a neutral stance, claiming that the present information on the bacteria is not enough for any scientific clarity.

October 7th- The Greek Government announced that they are initiating an immediate program for the controlling of the refugees and their placement in the island of Euboia. The refugees will not be able to cross over to the mainland of the Greece and consequently they will no longer pose a threat to the border security of the European Union.

October 9th - The number of infected people have risen to 104 in Nizhny Novgorod and 2 patients have lost their lives, yet still Patient Zero is alive.

October 10th - Artificial blood is produced by Swedish scientists to be used in post operation treatments. This new is accepted as revolution in medicine.

October 11th- A malfunction in the laboratory premises of the Juntendo University caused a 3-minute shortage of oxygen and vital hormones that were continuously provided to a human fetus that was developing under the first full-time ectogenesis trial in Japan. The Juntendo University published a press release expressing their great sadness regarding the event and that all of the authorized scientists that were working on the project are under review for sabotage possibilities. The Head Scientist for the project, Dr. Iarikino stated in an interview that they will find the actual cause of the event and make sure that no more malfunctions will happen in a retrial.

October 15th- EU has initiated negotiations with Albania, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and Montenegro for membership. Along with this, with the statement, asserting that Serbia should endeavor to tackle the Kosovo problem for initiation of the negotiations, it has also stressed the importance of having good relations with the neighboring countries.

October 16th- People's Republic of China dealt with a Tibetan Independence Movement protest supporting the actions of the Catalanian Government. Protesters demanded their independence pointing Catalonia out as an example for self-determination. A government spokesman delivered after the suppression of the protest that resulted with no fatal casualties; *“ The People's Republic of China will stand as a unity and will not answer to the individual sounds of such separatist groups, for the reason that this would only lead to chaos and the shattering of the nations across the globe. International Law is a controversial branch of law and cannot be put right over the highest norms of the domestic law. These findings vary according to various legal theories about the effectiveness of the international law. One undisputable fact is that there is no tool of enforcement of the said international norms to break into our homes and forcibly create a new State for the separatist groups. Thus, as a sovereign State we will stand behind our perspective that believes in the respect for the legislative authority of a State and the sense of togetherness in our nation. ”*

October 22nd- A referendum on full independence was held in Greenland. The voters decided to remain in the current relationship with Denmark, by a vote of %68.

October 24th- The United Nations Commission on Population and Development drafted a report encouraging several states to the removal of bans on ectogenesis technology. Turkish Minister of Health Kevser Günver, representing a country strictly opposing this procedure, stated that Turkey will never fold before this execution that disrespects the natural miracle of birth and that they will always stand against it to avoid the abuse of the said technology.

October 25th- “Mercy killing Sandstorms” are nightmare for Arabian countries. Sanctum lands for the Muslim world, Mecca and Medina are tyrannized with the sandstorms rooting from the

Southern desert areas. With the climate change and expansion of drought areas to nearly 15% Arabian district currently holds Saharan conditions and environment of 2013 according to Greenpeace's latest environment report.

October 22nd- The Indian Government publicly supported the Tokyo Conference on the Peaceful Usage of the Space and noted that government officials and ISRO representatives are in the preparation process for the conference in Tokyo.

October 23rd- The German Government encourages the European Union to hold a summit for a discussion on the suspension of the Schengen Agreement. The country is concerned for their future security and sovereignty.

October 24th- Famous American novelist George R. R. Martin, best known for the series of Game of Thrones, died in a tragic plane crash. The members of scenario team of the TV series and HBO show runners David Benioff and Dan Weiss who were the only people who knew the end of the series, were in the plane as well. There were not any survivors. The sixteenth forthcoming novel of Martin, The Winds of Death was not complete yet. Besides millions of readers and fans of the TV show, US, UK and Iceland had declared one day of national mourning. Because of the sudden decrease in the stock market values of HBO and Time Warner Inc., U.S. stock market had faced an alarming fluctuation.

October 25th - The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation has made a statement that has taken most of the Western world in shock apparently. A spokesman from the Foreign Ministry has stated that they are currently evaluating the possibility of a "Biological Warfare Attempt" by which Russian Federation has been targeted.

October 26th- United States Department of Defense (DoD) released the information on their new surveillance system on space debris. The DoD managed to upgrade their previous system to track orbital debris as small as 1 inch. The DoD official Susan Garrett stated that the orbit of the Sun and the Earth are filled with pieces of debris, which include naturally or artificially formed objects and that the man-made artificial objects are usually gathered around the Earth and especially the low Earth orbit, where the Space Stations and various Satellites are placed. Ms. Garrett noted that, currently there are more than 100.000 pieces of debris larger than a softball and approximately 800.000 debris larger than a marble. October 29th- United States Department of Defense (DoD) released the information on their new surveillance system on space debris. The DoD managed to upgrade their previous system to track orbital debris as small as 1 inch. The DoD official Susan Garrett stated that the orbit of the Sun and the Earth are filled with pieces of debris, which include naturally or artificially formed objects

October 29th- The United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Use of the Space (UN COPUOS) discussed the Tokyo Treaty in its subcommittees and the treaty was adopted by the UN COPUOS members with a unanimous vote.

October 30th - The number of people who are affected from the Katya Disease has reached 276. The number of casualties is 38. Patient Zero is still alive and her survival has indeed become a topic heated debates between doctors and medical professionals. Minzdrav have stated that the numbers are alarming and therefore requested aid from China, India and Iran on the issue of developing an effective vaccine.

November

November 4th- 3D Printing now is compatible with organic matter. John Hopkins University printed the first functioning liver.

November 9th- The Pingtang telescope, one of the world's largest radio telescopes was completed in Guangzhou, China, that costs 102 million US Dollars. With the new giant telescope, Chinese space monitoring devices are perceived as rival to means of NASA's space program.

November 12th- The biggest protest for the Donetsk Wall since its completion happened today. Approximately 4000 people demanding the destruction of the Wall chanted and marched against the fight between the two governments. The Police intervention resulted in the deaths of 35 protesters and 6 police officers.

November 13th - bomb exploded the security points of Chinese Forces in Tibet. 12 people were killed including the suicide bomber woman, and Chinese soldiers. On the other hand, Protestors marched the governor's office. On their way, seven protestors were shot dead. The leader of independence movement's of Tibet told that: *"The uprising shall continue until the freedom is achieved and the land is for Tibet and its people. China should be respect Tibetan's self-determination."*

November 16th- Albania, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and Montenegro fulfilled the Copenhagen Criteria and therefore received the chance to be a member state in the EU.

November 19th -The President of United States of America, Donald J. Trump said: *"Every day, people die in Donetsk. Russia and their pro-Russian militants were creating an outdoor prison in Ukraine. The US will continue supporting Ukraine Government. Every State should respect the territorial integrity of Ukraine. There is a difference between supporting groups seeking independence or the mandate of another State and marching into the land of another country and building a wall in the middle of their territory."*

December

December 23rd- Dr. O'neere from Cornell University applied for a patent on the upgraded artificial womb to the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO). The USPTO Patent Examiner Ilquerre Blackstone granted the patent claims on the patent but took the view that a specific claim, targeting specifically the womb consisting solely human cells, were actually unobvious and new compared to prior art. Although, the Examiner decided to refuse the claim on the womb itself due to the innovations direct relation to the human physiology. Dr. O'neere, applied to the Board of Appeals of the USPTO, which upheld the decision of the Examiner.

2022

January

January 2nd- A project for a seawall in Bangkok has officially been commenced. The wall will not solve the sinking problem but could protect the people and the property of central Thailand for many years.

January 10th- The Turkish Government addressed the Euboia Island situation and stated that the island was once populated by people only over a number of 200.000. The fact that nearly a million refugees have been placed among the peaceful inhabitants in Euboia is a humanitarian disgrace for both the refugees and the Greek citizens in Euboia. How are those people supposed to live together, when their health and culture status are showing extreme differences?

January 16th- President of Russian Federation, Vladimir Putin, addressed his people; *“Do not be afraid of the existence of this wall and do not ever misinterpret our intentions behind this action. We do not fear what lies beyond the wall! We only fear that our brothers and sisters will be slaughtered just because they want to determine their own destiny by officially joining our prideful nation. It is our duty to protect our people.”*

January 18th - In 2016, In 2012, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia had only 0.005 gigawatts of installed solar energy capacity. More than half of its electricity was produced from burning oil. By 2022, it has 41 gigawatts of installed solar energy, accounting for a third of the nation's 123 gigawatts total energy demand

February

February 10th - In Brazil, some rightist parties, including Democrats and Social Christian Party with the leadership of Progressive Party started to be organized against the leftist government.

February 19th- The Latakia Explosion victims and the people running away from the ongoing conflicts in Syria are migrating towards Turkey, Jordan and Lebanon.

February 20th- The reconstruction of Bangkok is not successful as the city is still sinking in the clay ground it is built on. The seawalls have eroded and the government seems to be out of solutions. Evacuations begun, the city is likely to be underwater by the end of the century.

February 21st - Russian authorities have stated that the neighborhoods of Nizhny Novgorod have been successfully quarantined and even in the worst case scenario the number of people who are

affected from the disease is no expected to be above 2,000. Also, they have once again defended the theories of a potential biological warfare. The spokesman said: “Nizhny Novgorod is the fifth largest city in whole Russian Federation and it is geographically close to many strategic points and other major cities. It is obvious that the Russian Federation has been the victim of a hideous aggression. If there is such an attack, we do guarantee that its actors and supporters will be exposed and justice shall be done.”

February 22nd- The biggest entertainment park on the planet, Disney World Baku in Azerbaijan opens its doors to its first visitors.

February 25th - A deputation formed by 3 rightist parties, Progressive Party, Democrats and Social Christian Party, went to Washington D.C meet with the President of the US.

March

March 3rd- The Coca Cola Company starts campaigning against COCA-TRIP claiming that it contains high amounts of alkaloids that amount to 20 grams of cocaine per bottle. COCA-TRIP immediately rejects this accusation and publishes information on the consumption of coca leaves by chewing and the coca tea that is traditional in many South American countries. The President of Bolivia, Bathilda Bodoro states that “...it is a stimulator, with effects not unlike those of black tea and coffee, and even the unhealthy beverage ‘coke’ which is now on the fall as the people see how nature provides us better nutrition than biologically and genetically manipulated ‘sodas’. This is also the reason they are trying to propaganda against us...”

April

April 7th- Lake Chad has completely dried. The people utilizing its ecosystem for agriculture, fishing and drinking water are worried.

April 13th - Micronesia joined Biological Weapons Treaty. But few remaining countries is still outside the Convention: Angola- South Sudan- Chad- Namibia- Samoa.

April 18th- The President of the United States of America Donald J. Trump spoke about the situation in Donetsk; “The United States of America takes this decision of the Russian Federation as an outrageous and vandal attitude. As the modern nations of the year 2022, we do not get to act on our primary instincts. Russia cannot hide from the reaction of Ukraine or any other nation by building a wall. The World History teaches us better by showing what could be the consequences of such actions. We support the abolishment of the Wall and encourage Russia to solve this matter through diplomacy. Because, even though “the protection of the Donetsk people from the Ukrainian forces” is presented as an objective; Russia has endangered much more people by creating this line, considering that the ones trying to break through the Wall are being shot at sight.”

February 17th –The excessive crowd and the lack of resources in Euboia leads the refugees to seek other homes. As only a little portion of the Alevi refugees are tending to go back to Syria, the coasts of Turkey and Greece mainland is starting to be occupied by refugees.

February 23rd- Occupy Central, a nonviolent occupation protest for universal suffrage, gathers in China.

May

May 15th- The United States of America, Central Intelligence Agency announces that they completed new project on “mind-reading” software to be installed in public areas that need sensitivity regarding security. The project will be tested in various simulations before their actual installment. The Head of CIA stated; “ *We received numerous questions on the mentioned technology and people seem to doubt the achievability of this. I would like to state on behalf of my Agency that we are not aiming to crack into people’s brains and extract words or images. Our studies have created a software that analyses the brainwaves, body temperature, facial expressions and movement of people and determines, through an algorithm, the likeliness of a person to commit a crime. Yet, we still rely on our country and our scientists for their ability to use this step to reach into people’s minds. I can assure you that even such an accomplishment will be held under control and used only for the grand security concerns of our military.*”

June

June 14th- United States Court of Customs and Patent Appeals (CCPA) heard the appeal brought by Dr. Equinne O’neere, the inventor of the first fully-functioning artificial womb of the US. Counsel for the USPTO, Quannal Kahn argued that the case differentiated from the landmark decision of Diamond v. Chakrabarty since the claimed invention included only human material and thus there is a great legal significance to the fact that those organisms are alive. The CCPA agreed with the USPTO and decided that the rejection of the claim was proper.

June 22nd- Meney Angel de Lucas issued his first book “I am a Lion! I swear”. The author who is a strong supporter of the Catalanian Independence emphasized that self-determination is the cardinal principle of international law and any practice that undermines the notion is in vain. The book made an enormous impact while the time was closing in for the referendum.

July

July 17th- CNN reported ; “ *The nuclear explosion in Syria continues to effect the already conflicted county. There is now an unpopulated area in Syria that resulted from the evacuation process initiated by the UN Security Council and the local groups around the area. It was not difficult to succeed in evacuation, since approximately 250.000 people died and 100.000 were severely injured. The area bounded by Latakia at West, Khan Shaykhun at East, Al Janoudiyah at North and Babdh at the South; is not habited by any persons currently. Latakia is now abandoned to be a ghost town while the victims are being treated in Buffer Zones in Turkey and various other camps throughout East Syria. As the southern tip of Turkey, Antakya is partially affected and evacuated, Turkey will need help from other countries for humanitarian aid and the housing of the victims. It is rumored that the European Union, once again is discussing about closing the border within themselves, if the victims were to move towards Greece.*”

July 22th- Netherlands supported Germany regarding the Greek failure on the refugee problem and suggested that the Union to go into talks about the Schengen Agreement before it is too late.

July 23rd - FIFA World Cup kicked-off, organized in Qatar, the first Islamic country to ever host the event.

July 25th- Nano Medic, Body Part Maker, Space Pilot, Orbital Tour Guide, Virtual Lawyer are some of the newest types of occupation.

July 26th- Several Countries declare level 7 emergency on climate; shut down establishments thought as danger to the protection and preservation of clean air. cities in member states such as PRC, USA, Japan, and TR are planned to be evacuated due to heavy pollution and emergency cases of poisoning. It is reported that in some of the cities, the sun almost doesn't shine or even seen.

August

August 10th - Pro-Ukrainian groups in west Donetsk launched missiles into settlements in East Donetsk, killing 5 civilian and wounding 14 according to Russia claims. Yet the independent news sources claim that the casualties are from the military.

September

September 10th- The Sunni rebels of Syria broadcasted a video online and spread the following message; “ After the escape of Assad, our country is facing yet another disaster. We will not let the blood of our brothers to have spilled for nothing. As the Free People of Syria, we appreciate the help of the States helping our victims. Yet, as we are fighting the remains of the former dictatorship and the ones we used to count as our friends; we need further help in reconstructing our destroyed cities.”

October

October 10th- The Unpopulated Area in Syria is still not attended.

October 22nd- Germany decided that to shot down 9 operating nuclear plants and changed the status of 8 other plants from “temporarily closed” to “permanently closed”.

November

November 2nd- The European Southern Observatory completed the construction of a space telescope located in the Cerro Amazons of Chile. The device allows the scientists to observe the universe in more detail than the Hubble Space Telescope to the extend of reaching to the atmospheres of extra solar planets

November 17th- The Alevi group in North Syria (namely in Al-Safirah Al Tabqah and Ar Raqqah), as known as the Redemption Army, kidnapped and violently executed 10 fighters from the Free People of Syria. The Head of the alevi organization, Zilyed el-Payli stated that they will never abandon their causes and will become the next legitimate government of Syria.

December

December 7th- The “mind-reading” security cameras are installed to several undisclosed airports, train stations and public squares of the United States.

December 9th- As more wounded and terrified Syrians are banging on the doors of the Turkish Buffer Zones, Turkey struggles to provide housing, food and medical care. The overcrowding issue leads the refugees to aim farther countries.

December 18th - Chile is now home to another space telescope, the Large Synoptic Survey Telescope, in Cerro Pachon.

December 20th - After the world population increased more than 400% over the 20th century, the population growth is now much slower because of global warming, ongoing battles and nuclear disaster. Consequently, between the 2016 and 2022, the population of the world has grown from 7.4 billion to 7.6 billion. According to data of the United Nations Population division, the list of ten countries with the highest population in the world is as follows:
